Thus the directions disclose that the validity of the sports certificate should be before 16.05.2017 and the Applicant has secured the validity in April, 2016. Thus, Sr. No.2 of the said note states that as per corrigendum dated 18.08.2016 the validation cerrificate should be on or before 16.05.2017 and it is to be produced before the appointment i.e. "नियुक्तीपर्वी". On query it is found that the State has no explanation or any other interpretation of this Thus, as the applicant was holding the validation certificate before 16.05.2017 and in view that already one post is kept vacant by way of interim order and he has also completed training pursuant to the order of the Hon'ble High Court, hence, the Applicant is entitled for appointment and posting. However, Applicant is directed to produce the validation certificate and it is to be taken on record before issuing the order of his appointment.

7. In view of above, O.A. stands allowed.
