The main contention raised by the Ld. Advocate is that the applicants have passed the departmental examination for Class I officers and therefore now they are appointed as Class I officer by way of nomination after they appeared for MPSC examination. Ld. Advocate submits that the applicants have already passed the departmental examination when they were on Class II post. Hence, there is no necessity to appear for the examination for Class I post again. She points out rule 8 of Recruitment Rules dated 5.8.1983 and submits that they cannot be denied promotion.
- Ld. CPO on instructions informs that proposal has been submitted to the Govt. wherein three posts are kept aside for seeking orders as to whether promotions can be given to two applicants and one more candidate, subject to passing of the departmental examination on promotional post.
- Applicants seek their consideration for promotion on the ground that they have passed the examination. Applicant No.1 was working as Taluka Agriculture Officer and applicant no.2 as Technical Officer. They have passed the examination on 17.1.2002 and 11.6.2003 respectively. Ld. Advocate submits that though were nominated for Class I post on 7.7.2009 and they have already completed probation and granted permanency. During the last DPC held in

- Ld. CPO opposes on the ground that she refers to Examination Rules of 20.6.1981 wherein it is stated that they are required to pass the departmental examination. Ld. CPO submits that proposal as to whether these two applicants can be issued orders of promotion has been submitted to the Government for orders subject to passing examination.
- However, in view of the fact that posts are likely to be filled up, we grant interim relief in terms of prayer clause 10(b) and we direct respondents to keep vacant one post at Pune and one post at Amravati respectively.

The names of the applicants were not appearing in the provisional list and hence OA is filed on No post was reserved in advt. for NT-D 28.1.2021. category. Cut off marks was 159 out of 200. Applicants secured 169 and 168 respectively and therefore applicants have made respondent no.3 & 4 as party respondents as they are Sr. No.9 & 10 in the provisional list of Bandsman as they have secured less mark than the applicants. Ld. Advocate submits that for 10 posts of Bandsman there was no reservation either vertical or horizontal. In support of his claim he relies on the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in MA No.2641/2019 in SLP No.23223/2018 Saurav Yadav & Ors. Vs. State of U.P. & Ors. decided on 18.12.2020.

- 4. After hearing Ld. Advocate and as we have mentioned the issue is short we are of the view that it appears that department has exfacie violated the law of migration of the reserved category vertically. The applicants have mentioned their caste as NT-D. They were meritorious in view of the marks secured by them than the last two candidates in the select list of Bandsman. We do not want to disturb the appointments given to respondents no.3 & 4 because we do not find any fault of these two persons as they have put in service of four years.
- 5. Ld. CPO informs that in the affidavit respondent no.2 has denied the case of the applicants.
- 6. We make it clear that we express our view that law of the land which is settled in the case of Indra Sawhney Vs. Union of India AIR 1993 SC 477 and R.K. Sabharwal & Ors. Vs. State of Punjab & Ors. AIR 1995 SC 1371 in respect of migration, on the basis of merit irrespective of caste or category the candidate belongs to. Ld. CPO express her agreement with this view.
- 7. Under such circumstances we call upon respondent no.2 to inform whether applicants can be accommodated against any vacancies of the 2018 selection for Bandsman. We also call upon respondent no.2 whether in any other way the applicants can be accommodated in future vacancies.

2. The applicants pray that respondent no.2 be directed to consider claim of the applicant for appointment to the post of Police Bandsman. The interim relief is in the nature of final relief. Hence, it is heard finally at the interim stage.

Reply is filed on behalf of respondent no.2. Both applicants have applied through NT-D category. Applicant no.1 secured 90 marks and applicant no.2 secured 94 marks out of 100. On 7.4.2018 practical and written examination were conducted. Applicants secured 79 and 74 marks respectively out of 100. Provisional list was published on 8.5.2018. The names of the applicants were not appearing in the provisional list and hence OA is filed on No post was reserved in advt. for NT-D 28.1.2021. category. Cut off marks was 159 out of 200. Applicants secured 169 and 168 respectively and therefore applicants have made respondent no.3 & 4 as party respondents as they are Sr. No.9 & 10 in the provisional list of Bandsman as they have secured less mark than the applicants. Ld. Advocate submits that for 10 posts of Bandsman there was no reservation either vertical or horizontal. In support of his claim he relies on the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in MA No.2641/2019 in SLP No.23223/2018 Saurav Yadav & Ors. Vs. State of U.P. & Ors. decided on 18.12.2020.

- 4. After hearing Ld. Advocate and as we have mentioned the issue is short we are of the view that it appears that department has exfacie violated the law of migration of the reserved category vertically. The applicants have mentioned their caste as NT-D. They were meritorious in view of the marks secured by them than the last two candidates in the select list of Bandsman. We do not want to disturb the appointments given to respondents no.3 & 4 because we do not find any fault of these two persons as they have put in service of four years.
- 5. Ld. CPO informs that in the affidavit respondent no.2 has denied the case of the applicants.
- 6. We make it clear that we express our view that law of the land which is settled in the case of Indra Sawhney Vs. Union of India AIR 1993 SC 477 and R.K. Sabharwal & Ors. Vs. State of Punjab & Ors. AIR 1995 SC 1371 in respect of migration, on the basis of merit irrespective of caste or category the candidate belongs to. Ld. CPO express her agreement with this view.
- 7. Under such circumstances we call upon respondent no.2 to inform whether applicants can be accommodated against any vacancies of the 2018 selection for Bandsman. We also call upon respondent no.2 whether in any other way the applicants can be accommodated in future vacancies.

Professor Associate Professor Assistant Professor Statistician (Tutor/Asstt. Prof.) Tutor/Demonstrator/Sr. Resident.

- 4. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant was appointed and has worked as Assistant Professor in Government Medical College, Aurangabad from 1.8.2019 to 9.8.2020 as a bond service. The applicant was working as Assistant Professor which is higher to the Senior Resident. Learned counsel for the applicant further relies on the note for the purpose of working out the deficiency, wherein it is mentioned that any excess teaching faculty in higher cadre can compensate the deficiency of lower cadre of the same department only.
- 5. Learned C.P.O submits that the applicant does not have experience of Senior Resident and therefore her case was not considered by M.P.S.C.
- 6. Prima facie, we find that there is substance in the submissions of the learned counsel for the applicant. We also considered the experience of 1 year & 8 days put in by the applicant for the post of Assistant Professor for which she wishes to apply. However, as per MCI norms non-clinical post i.e. Community Medicine does not require one year experience.
- 7. Under the circumstances, we direct the M.P.S.C to allow the applicant to appear for the interview which is going to be held on 26.9.2022. However, the same will be subject to the outcome of this Original Application.
- 8. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.
