This is an application for condonation of delay in filing the Contempt Application.

The learned P.O. strongly opposes this application *inter-alia* pointing out that there is no provision for condonation of delay.

We find no substance in the objections and in the interest of justice, the application is allowed and Contempt Application No.98/2016 is taken up for hearing.

Upon perusal of record and proceedings, we find that in the order of Tribunal of which the breach has <sup>been</sup> alleged in para 7, the respondents were directed to conduct an enquiry afresh on the allegations of the applicant and issue a reasoned order containing conclusions thereof and inform it to the applicant. This has not been done though as appeared in the order of 9.7.2014, this Tribunal granted three months time from 9.7.2014. However, from the Contempt Application it appears that the proper identification of the officers with the precise allegations against them has not been made and even the applicant informs that the respondent no.1 has now been transferred. Therefore, the applicant shall <sup>clearly</sup> imply as to which human agency he seeks <sup>the</sup> contempt notice <sup>to</sup> be issued.

As per the recent communication from the Government, the case of the Petitioner will be considered at level of Head of the Department i.e. the Director General, Information & Public Relations, itself. For fresh consideration of request of the Petitioner,-

- i) It is essential to public final seniority list as on dated 01/09/1978 and temporary seniority list as on dated 01/01/1982.
- ii) It is also essential to prepare roster since year 1974 and it is to be checked by the Competent Authority.
- iii) Afterwards, it is require to take a meeting of the Departmental Promotion Committee for considering the case of the Petitioner for granting him deemed date of promotion.”

(Quoted from letter dated 23.12.2016 received from Shri Ajay Ambekar, Director (Information) (Administration).

3. Learned P.O. for the Respondents further prayers that six months time may be granted.

4. Request of the learned P.O. for the Respondents Shri K.B. Bhise can be considered on the condition that schedule be planned and must be meticulously followed without being required to apply for extension of time.
5. Learned P.O. for the Respondents assures that the schedule would be adhered to.






