- 2. The applicant has filed the present Original Application challenging the order dated 03.09.2020 issued by respondent No. 2, thereby rejecting request of the applicant for grant of time bound promotion after completion of 12 years of service. Respondent No. 2 by letter dated 03.09.2020 rejected the application filed by the applicant dated 21.08.2020. The applicant has filed the present Misc. Application seeking condonation of delay caused in filing the accompanying O.A.
- 3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that from 25.02.2020 onwards due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic, the Government has declared lockdown and issued guidelines to be followed by the public. In consequence thereof, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India by order dated 27.03.2021

in **Suo Motu Writ Petition (Civil) No. 3 of 2020** has extended the period of limitation, taking into consideration the said outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic. The applicant, therefore, could not prefer Original Application immediately and as such, there is delay of 73 days in filing the accompanying O.A. Learned counsel submitted that the circumstances were beyond the control of the applicant and the delay is neither intentional nor deliberate. Learned counsel submits that the delay thus caused in filing the accompanying O.A. deserves to be condoned.

- 4. Learned P.O. has strongly resisted the application on the ground that there is an inordinate delay caused in filing the O.A. and the delay has not been explained satisfactorily. Learned P.O. submits that the Misc. Application is liable to be dismissed.
- 5. The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in **Suo Motu Writ Petition (Civil) No. 3 of 2020**, in para No. 2 has issued following directions:-
 - "2. We have considered the suggestions of the learned Attorney General for India regarding the future course of action. We deem it appropriate to issue the following directions: -
 - 1. In computing the period of limitation for any suit, appeal, application or proceeding, the

period from 15.03.2020 till 14.03.2021 shall stand excluded. Consequently, the balance period of limitation remaining as on 15.03.2020, if any, shall become available with effect from 15.03.2021.

- 2. In cases where the limitation would have expired during theperiod between 15.03.2020 till 14.03.2021, notwithstanding the actual balance period of limitation remaining, all persons shall have a limitation period of 90 days from 15.03.2021. In the event the actual balance period of limitation remaining, with effect from 15.03.2021, is greater than 90 days, that longer period shall apply.
- 3. The period from 15.03.2020 till 14.03.2021 shall also stand excluded in computing the periods 2 | P a g e prescribed under Sections 23 (4) and 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, Section 12A of the Commercial Courts Act, 2015 and provisos (b) and (c) of Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and any other laws, which prescribe period(s) of limitation for instituting proceedings, outer limits (within which the court or tribunal can condone delay) and termination of proceedings.
- 4. The Government of India shall amend the guidelines for containment zones, to state. "Regulated movement will be allowed for medical emergencies, provision of essential goods and services, and other necessary time functions, such as, bound applications, including for legal purposes, and educational and job-related requirements."

- 6. In view of above, the period from 15.03.2020 till 14.03.2021 has been excluded and insofar as balance period is concerned, the persons concerned shall have a limitation period of 90 days from 15.03.2020. In the instant case, the applicant has filed O.A. on 17.03.2021.
- 7. There is no intentional / deliberate delay. There is no inaction or negligence on part of the applicant. The circumstances were beyond his control. The delay thus deserves to be condoned. Hence, the following order:-

ORDER

- (i) M.A. No. 99/2021 is hereby allowed.
- (ii) The delay of 73 days caused in filing the accompanying O.A. is hereby condoned.
- (iii) Accompanying O.A. be registered and numbered in accordance with law.
- (iii) Accordingly, M.A. stands disposed of without any order as to costs.
