4. The request of the applicant was earlier refused and according to the applicant it was refused as there was one criminal case pending against him. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that after the applicant got acquitted of the said criminal case again proposal has been moved and the same is pending for consideration before the higher authority i.e. the State Government. The contention so raised is affirmed in the affidavit in reply filed on behalf of respondent Nos. 2 & 3. Paragraph Nos. 3 and 14 are relevant, which read thus: -

“03. At the very outset, I most humbly say and submit that, the proposal of sanction of the leave of the applicant for the period 16.06.2010 to 30.04.2016 was forwarded by the office of respondent no. 3 to respondent no. 2 by communication dated 25.04.2019 and thereafter as per the communication dated 20.08.2021 the respondent No. 3 has furnished information as per communication dated 28.01.2022 and said proposal of the applicant regarding sanction of the leave was forwarded to the Government. I say that as there was some queries raised by the Government, after completion the said queries, the proposal of the applicant is resubmitted to the Government on 28.07.2022 by the respondent No. 2 for sanction of the leave of the

Application, and the same is pending for its decision. The copy of said proposal dated 28.07.2022 is annexed herewith and marked as **ANNEXURE R-1** for kind perusal of this Hon'ble Tribunal.

14. As regards to the contents of Para No. VI(I) of the Original Application, I say and submit that the contentions raised by the applicant under the heading Grounds from (I) to (IV) are denied by the present deponent. I humbly say and submit that, as mentioned above the decision regarding sanction of leave period of the applicant is pending with the Government and therefore after the said decision the grant of regular annual increments as per the 6th and 7th pay commission and, arrears can be taken.”

5. From the aforesaid averments in the affidavit in reply filed on behalf of respondent Nos. 2 and 3, it is evident that fate of the present application and the prayers made therein depend upon the decision of the Government on the proposal forwarded by respondent No. 2 to the Government. As has been revealed from the affidavit in reply filed on behalf of respondent Nos. 2 and 3 the proposal regarding sanction of leave period of the applicant is forwarded by respondent No. 2 to the Government on 28.7.2022. It is pending with the Government since then. In premise of the facts as aforesaid without going into the merits of the contentions raised in the present O.A., it can be

disposed of with the following directions. Hence, the following order: -
