ORAL ORDER:

Heard Shri K.G. Salunke, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri I.S. Thorat, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondent Nos.1 to 3.

- 2. Record shows that affidavit-in-reply is filed on behalf of the Respondent Nos.1 to 3 to which affidavit-in-rejoinder is filed by the Applicant. The Respondent Nos.1 to 3 have also filed affidavit-in-sur-rejoinder.
- 3. Respondent No.4 is absent though duly served and has not filed affidavit-in-reply.
- 4. Learned P.O. for Respondent Nos.1 to 3 on instructions submits that the Respondent No.4 i.e. Smt. Sumitra Rajhans Jadhav is retired on superannuation w.e.f. 30.06.2021. - 5. The Original Application is filed challenging the impugned transfer order of the Applicant dated 12.2.2019 (Annexure 'A-2', page no.14 of P.B.). The Applicant has also challenged the transfer order of the Respondent No.4 dated 12.2.2019 (Annexure 'A-5', page no.17 of P.B.). Both the impugned orders are passed by the Respondent No.2 i.e. Superintending Engineer, Public Works Circle, Aurangabad. By the transfer order of Respondent No.4, she has been brought in the place of Applicant and the Applicant has been transferred from Jalna to Partur.
- 6. Record shows that by order dated 06.03.2019 interim relief is granted by this Tribunal whereby both the impugned transfer orders were stayed.
- 7. Learned P.O. as well as Respondent No.3 who is present before this Tribunal submit that the Applicant is retiring within a period of 11 months i.e. by 30.06.2022. In view of the same, the Respondents are not going to disturb the present posting of the Applicant. The Applicant is working as Head Clerk, P.W.D. Jalna.
