- 2. The Original Application No. 628/2022 (Annexure A-10) is filed challenging impugned communication dated 21.06.2022 (Annexure A-10) issued by the respondent No. 5 i.e. the Education Officer (Primary), Zilla Parishad, Osmanabad, thereby refusing to give certificate of Scheduled-8 as regards experience for enabling the applicant to submit it at the time of oral interview.
- 3. During pendency of the O.A., separate affidavits in reply on behalf of respondent No. 1 and 5 respectively are filed. The O.A. was already fixed for hearing.

- 4. During pendency of the O.A., dates for interview are published vide Publication dated 16.06.2023 mentioning dates of oral interview as 26.06.2023 and 27.06.2023. In view of the same, the M.A. No. 279/2023 is taken out by the applicant seeking direction to the respondent No. 5 to certify Scheduled-8 for enabling the applicant to participate in the interview.
- 5. Initially the applicant was appointed as Primary / Assistant Teacher with Zilla Parishad Prashala, Tandulwadi, Tq. Bhum, Dist. Osmanabad. In the year 2009, he was promoted on the post of Graduate Teacher. Further in the year 2013, he was promoted on the post of Secondary Teacher. The applicant has completed 19 years, 1 month and 9 days service as Assistant Teacher with Zilla Parishad Primary School and 3 years, 9 months and 13 days service as Secondary School with Zilla Parishad High Schools till January, 2017.
- 6. The School Education and Sports Department, State of Maharashtra issued Government Circular dated 17.05.2017 (Annexure A-1) on the website of

MPSC, thereby applications for Limited Departmental Competitive Examinaion-2017 were called for selection to the post of Maharashtra Education Services Group-B (Administrative Branch). Pursuant to the said Circular, applicant applied for the said post. The requisite written examination was conducted, in which the applicant participated. The applicant is declared pass in the merit list dated 01.04.2022 (Annexure A-8), in which his name is at Sr. No. 182.

- 7. As per the Circular, the experience certificate in requisite form of Scheduled-8 is required to be submitted by the applicant at the time of interview. In view of the same, the applicant made application to the respondent No. 5 dated 16.04.2022 (Annexure A-9) for getting Scheduled-8 certificate. However, the respondent No. 5 by impugned communication dated 21.06.2022 (Annexure A-10) has denied to grant certificate in Scheduled-8 form.
- 8. Learned Presenting Officer opposed the submissions raised on behalf of the applicant and placed on record a copy of order dated 25.07.2022

delivered in O.A. No. 391/2022 with C.A. No. 169/2022 in the matter of Sandip Bribhansingh Somwanshi & Ors. Vs. State of Maharashtra and Ors. And 3 other O.As. and contended that similar reliefs were not considered. In our opinion, this decision can be taken into consideration at the time of final hearing of the O.A.

9. Now it is a fact that interviews are scheduled on 26th and 27th, June, 2023 vide publication dated 16.06.2023 issued by the respondent No. 5 MPSC as stated in M.A. No. 279/2023. Requisite certificate in the form of Scheduled-8 to be given by the respondent No. 5 is a technical issue, even though, the applicant has completed 22 years of experience in District Technical Services, Group-C. In view of that, refusing to grant interim relief is likely to cause irreparable loss to the applicant. The selection of the applicant, if any, would be governed by subject to outcome of the O.A. No. 628/2022 and the result of the applicant can be ordered to be kept in sealed cover. Interim relief as above is granted further directing the respondent No. 5 to allow and to

participate the applicant in the interview process, which is scheduled on 26^{th} and 27^{th} June, 2023.

The Original Application No. 422/2022 is filed by the applicants challenging the merit list of written examination publication / Notification dated 01.04.2022 (Annexure A-10) by the respondent No. 2 i.e. the MPSC and to direct the respondent No. 2 to publish it afresh and seeking stay to the said merit list.
- 4. The affidavit in reply (page Nos. 116 to 175) is filed jointly on behalf of respondent No. 1 to 4 and separate affidavit in reply is filed on behalf of

respondent No. 2. During pendency of the O.A., it appears that the learned Advocate for the applicant has not collected the copies of the said affidavits in reply.

- 5. Perusal of the impugned seniority list vide publication dated 01.04.2022 (Annexure A-10) would show that the name of the applicant does not figure in the qualified candidates. The O.A. is pending since about 18.04.2022.
- 6. Now when the dates of interview are published by the respondent No. 2 MPSC vide Publication notice dated 16.06.2023, M.A. No. 280/2023 is taken out by the applicants pressing for interim relief of allowing the applicants to appear for the interview. The respondent No. 2 in it's affidavit in reply has raised following pleadings as regards posts to be filled in from DTS category, for which the applicants belong to, which is as follows:-
 - "9. I submit that for the post in issue. i.e. 'Deputy Education Officer' through 'Limited Departmental Competitive Examination 2017' candidates from the Maharashtra Education Services (MES) and District Technical Services (DTS) we eligible. For the 31 posts of MES cadre, candidates only from the MES cadre are eligible and for the 92 posts of DTS cadre. candidates

only from the DTS cadre are eligible. But in the application form for the examination many candidates had not filled up their cadre and hence it was not possible for the Commission to decide for which cadre their candidature would be considered. Therefore Commission made announcement on its website and also sent SMS to the candidates to furnish the information regarding their cadres. But many of candidates had not furnished it. As the Commission has no role in ascertaining the eligibility of the candidates for the departmental examination, Commission sought information regarding the cadres and eligibility of the candidates from the Government and Government sent the cadre-wise list of eligible candidates to the Commission. As per this list the applicant no. 1 to 3 were not held eliqible for the said exam for the any cadre by the Government and hence their candidature was not considered by the Commission while preparing the result 1.4.2022. The list of 'Not Eligible declared on Candidates-Decided by Government' was also published by the Commission on 21.4.2022. Copies of the relevant pages of the list of not eligible candidates showing the names of applicant no. i to 3 are attached herewith and marked as Exhibit R-2."

- 7. No rejoinder affidavit is filed in this regard and contentions were not dealt with in the O.A. and the applicants upon enquiry, could not point out explanation to the said contentions with the help of documents appended to the O.A.
- 8. In the circumstances as above, in our considered opinion, this is not a fit case to grant interim relief of allowing the applicants to appear for interview as prayed for in M.A. No. 280/2023. In the
