As per this list the applicant no. 1 to 3 were not held eligible for the said exam for the any cadre by the Government and hence their candidature was not considered by the Commission while preparing the result declared on 1.4.2022. The list of 'Not Eligible Candidates-Decided by Government' was also published by the Commission on 21.4.2022. Copies of the relevant pages of the list of not eligible candidates showing the names of applicant no. i to 3 are attached herewith and marked as Exhibit R-2."
