- Applicant who belongs to Orphan category, applied for the post of Clerk-Typist and Tax Assistant pursuant to advertisement dated 21.12.2021 issued by MPSC for Maharashtra Group-C Services Combined Preliminary Examination, 2021. Exams were conducted on 3.4.2022 and results were declared on 28.6.2022. Advertisement for Main Examination was issued on 28.6.2022 and applicant applied on 1.7.2022. Main Exams were held on 27.8.2022. His name appeared in the list of qualified candidates for Typing Test in Aurangabad Division for Tax Assistant and Clerk-Typist on 23.11.2022 and 7.12.2022 respectively. GR dated 7.7.2022 was issued by Government giving exemption to the orphans to produce Typing certificate within two years from the date of appointment. Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that the applicant has already secured Typing certificate dated 20.10.2022. Ld. Advocate submits that applicant has wrongly uploaded blank page with the application form. Ld. Advocate submits that Orphans are exempted from appearing for the Typing examination by GR dated 7.7.2022 and only certificates are to be produced.
- 3. Ld. CPO opposes the OA and she submits that applicant was not allowed to appear for the examination and defends the action of the MPSC disqualifying him from appearing the main examination. Ld. CPO submits that applicant made application on 1.7.2022 and when he made application, GR dated 7.7.2022 was not in existence. The examination was held on 7.12.2022. She submits that applicant in fact could not have submitted his application as he was not holding Typing certificate. Ld. CPO submitted that however, the applicant uploaded blank page along with his application and therefore his application was accepted by the computer. She submitted that uploading of blank page along with application is fraud played by the applicant on the MPSC and therefore he was rightly considered disqualified.
- 4. We have perused all the documents carefully. The applicant is an Orphan. Admittedly, when he filled application

form on 1.7.2022 the GR dated 7.7.2022 giving exemption to the Orphans to produce typing certificate was not available. The period of two years to produce such typing certificate was given to the Orphans. However, the examination was conducted on 7.12.2022 i.e. after issuance of GR and therefore considering the stage of selection process we hold that applicant is covered under said GR of 7.7.2022. The applicant was held disqualified mainly on the ground that his typing certificate was not within the He was not holding typing certificate of prescribed time. stipulated time. However, this objection is not sustainable in view of the exemption granted to the Orphans. We place reliance on the judgment and order dated 22.7.2022 passed by this Tribunal in OA No.693 of 2022 (Arjun Ramkrishnrao Tarke Vs. The State of Maharashtra & Anr.) allowing the OA. This order of the Tribunal is upheld by the Hon'ble High Court by its order dated 19.10.2022 passed in W.P. No.12210 of 2022 filed by the MPSC Vs. A.R. Tarke.

- One additional point raised by the Ld. CPO is that 5. applicant has deliberately uploaded blank page along with application form as if it was typing certificate. Ld. Advocate for the applicant admitted that it was blank page and also on instructions from the applicant admitted that he uploaded blank page because he thought that if such extra page is uploaded the computer will accept his application. He wanted his application to be accepted. We will not call this act of the applicant as fraud. It was not a doctored or forged document. We call it a 'clever trick' played by the applicant to process the application. Strictly he should not have done so. However, as all omissions cannot be construed as offence similarly all commission of act cannot be The entire system is treated as commission of offence. computerized and there was no specific command to the computer not to accept the blank page and therefore we allow this OA and his candidature to be considered as qualified for further process of selection, interview etc. In between the applicant has cleared typing examination and is having typing certificate, may be after the scheduled date, which is in fact not applicable to the Orphans.
 - 6. This order is passed in persona.
 - 7. Hence, we allow the OA and direct that said typing certificate of the applicant is to be accepted, if found true. We direct that case of the applicant is to be considered for appointment and necessary steps be taken by the respondents. No orders as to costs.

- 2. The Applicant has challenged the transfer order dated 10.01.2022 whereby he is transferred from Lonavala City Police Station to Junnar Police Station, Dist. Pune and already relieved on 19.03.2023. Though his transfer seems to be mid-term and mid-tenure, the file tendered by learned P.O. *prima-facie* shows that there are serious allegations of accepting bribe against the Applicant and it is on that background, the PEB exercising the power under Section 22N (2) of Maharashtra Police Act and transferred the Applicant in public interest and in administrative exigencies.
- 3. Learned Counsel for the Applicant sought to contend that the allegations are false and the transfer is issued without giving any show cause notice to the Applicant.
- 4. At this stage, *prima-facie* the PEB at district level exercised the power under Section 22N(2) of Maharashtra Police Act. Thus, the transfer seems to be *prima-facie* necessitated because of misconduct attributed to the Applicant.
- 5. In view of above, I am not inclined to grant interim relief.

- 8. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Private service is allowed. Respondents are put to notice that the case may be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
- 9. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
- 10. By Hand delivery, speed post, courier notice to be served and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.
- 11. In case notice is not collected within <u>seven</u> days or service report on affidavit is not filed <u>three</u> days before returnable date, the Original/ <u>Miscellaneous</u> Application shall be placed on board before the concerned Benches under the caption "<u>for Dismissal</u>" and thereafter on the subsequent date the Original / <u>Miscellaneous</u> Application shall stand dismissed.
