4. Curiously during the course of argument, it is transpired that as per Civil Services Board recommendations, the Applicant's transfer was recommended because of complaints about her functioning as Tahsildar, Mandrup, Dist. Solapur.

5. Thus, during the course of final hearing, it was tried to point out by learned P.O. as well as learned Counsel for the Respondent No.2 that in addition to issue of transfer on Non Executive post, there was issue of necessity of transfer because of complaints.

8. Needless to mention that the affidavit was required to be filed with utmost seriousness verifying the factual aspects but no such care has been taken by the concerned. It is further surprising to note that the draft of affidavit has been approved by the Joint Secretary Dr. Shri Veer as well as Additional Chief Secretary who too failed to verify the factual aspects.

9. In view of above, learned P.O. is directed to file the affidavit of Additional Chief Secretary who has verified the draft of affidavit and to make its stand clear and also to file affidavit of Shri Prakash Indalkar, Under Secretary.
