


Learned counsel for the applicants prays that the action of Respondents keeping 45 posts vacant by DPC dated 23.11.2022 and the DPC minutes dated 24.11.2022 is illegal and unconstitutional. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that his prayer for interim relief be considered and decided today so that he can move the Hon'ble High Court.</p> <p>3. Learned C.P.O wants to file affidavit in reply as the matter involves the issue of reservation based on Vijay Ghogre's case.</p> <p>4. We have gone through the noting of the D.P.C. filed by Mr Dere, learned counsel for the applicants. We make it clear that we will decide the issue of interim relief after securing affidavit-in-reply of the Respondents. There is no pressing urgency in hearing the interim relief today, as persuaded by learned counsel, in view of the relief claimed.</p> <p>5. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.</p> <p>6. Issue notice before admission returnable on 5.4.2023.</p> <p>7. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Private service is allowed. Respondents are put to notice that the case may be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.</p> <p>8. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.</p> <p>9.
