- 2. Learned Advocate for Applicants reiterates that Applicant in O.A. No. 439/2024 had given '5 Options' while Applicant in O.A. No. 441/2024 had given '3 Options' for transfer to 'Police Establishments' in 'Konkan 2 Division' after promotion to post of 'Police Inspector' but these were not considered as per 'DGP, Maharashtra State' Order dated 15.03.2024 for reasons which have been recorded in 'Para 7' and 'Para 8' of Order dated 28.03.2024.
- 3. The 'DGP, Maharashtra State' is now in process of filling up '354 Posts' of 'Police Inspector' in 'Konkan-2 Division' as per Order passed in O.A. No. 1268/2022 on 16.01.2024 and directions for its compliance given on 18.04.2024 in 'C.A.' No. 33/2024 in O.A. No. 1268/2022.
- 4. The O.A. No. 489/2024 and O.A. No. 444/2024 of Applicants are yet to be finally heard on points of law and merits of case. Further as some more time would be required by 'DGP, Maharashtra State' to re-examine allotment of 'Revenue Division' made to 'Police Inspectors' upon promotion from cadre of 'A.P.I.s' of '102-Batch' especially in respect of 'Konkan-2 Division'; therefore based on facts and circumstances relating to cases of Applicants and taking into due consideration that it would be necessary for 'DGP, Maharashtra State'

to forthwith issue orders of promotion to fill up '354 Posts' of 'Police Inspectors' as per directions given on 18.04.2024 in 'C.A.' No. 33/2024 in O.A. No. 1268/2022; it is directed that (a) '1 post' of 'Police Inspector' in establishment of either ACB/ Thane City/ Thane Rural/ Highway Security Force/ Police Center Marol be kept available in 'Konkan-2 Division' for Applicant in O.A. - 1. Heard Shri S.S. Dere, learned Advocate for the Applicants and Smt. Archana B.K., and Shri D.R. Patil, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that neither (a) 'Principal Secretary, Urban Development Department' nor (b) 'Municipal Commissioner, PMC' have taken any action to implement Order of 'Interim Relief' granted on 28.03.2024 permitting Applicant join back on post of 'Deputy Commissioner, PMC'.
- 3. Learned PO states that no specific information is yet available as to why orders of 'Interim Relief' granted on 28.03.2024 have not been implemented by either (a) 'Principal Secretary, Urban Development Department' and (b) 'Municipal Commissioner, PMC'.
- 4. The inaction on part of both (a) 'Principal Secretary, Urban Development and (b) Municipal Commissioner, PMC' thus amounts to willful disobedience of Order of 'Interim Relief' granted to Applicant on 28.03.2024. Hence; they are directed to 'Show Cause' as to why 'Suo Moto' proceedings under 'Contempt of Court Act: 1971' should not be initiated as per provisions of 'Rule 4' of MAT (Contempt of Court) Rules 1996 for their failure to implement Orders of 'Interim Relief' granted on 28.03.2024 to Applicant under provisions 'Section 24' of 'Administrative Tribunals Act 1985'.

- 1. Heard Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Smt. Archana B.K., learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. The 'Transport Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Mumbai' was directed to file 'Affidavit-in-Reply' by 04.04.2024, but it could not been done apparently on the grounds that 'Transport Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Mumbai' has been deputed as 'E.C.I. Observer' for 'General Election Lok Sabha 2024'.
- 3. The 'Affidavit-in-Reply' dated 27.02.2024 filed on behalf of 'R.T.O. Thane' emphasizes that Order dated 25.04.2023 passed by 'Deputy R.T.O.' does not violate any provisions of 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005'. The Order dated 25.04.2023 passed by 'Dy. R.T.O. Thane' is thus of 'Administrative Nature' and issued after prior approval of 'R.T.O, Thane' who being 'Administrative Head' has powers to shift any 'Government Servant' under him from one place to another which is within office of 'R.T.O. Thane'.
- 4. The 'Affidavit-in-Reply' which was filed earlier on 27.02.2024 on behalf of 'R.T.O. Thane' mentions that both 'Old Building and New Building' are part of offices premises of 'R.T.O. Thane', and they are located within distance of 3 Kms 'Old Building' also has about 20 Ministerial Staff' and provided with facilities of Washroom.

#### Tribunal's orders

- 5. The 'Affidavit-in-Reply' dated 27.02.2024 filed on behalf of 'R.T.O. Thane' also mentions states that 'Senior Officer' has been directed to look into compliant of Applicant and take appropriate action. The services of Applicant are not to be utilized only by 'R.T.O. Thane' but by other 'Senior Officers' as well sitting in 'Old Building'. Further as per norms no separate 'Cabin' has been provided to 'Stenographer (Lower Grade)'.
- 'Affidavit-in-Reply' The of 'Transport Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Mumbai' will take some time to be placed on record as 'Transport Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Mumbai' is now away for work as 'E.C.I. Observer' for 'General Election of Lok Sabha 2024'. Further as 'R.T.O. Thane' has not on his own accord revoked Order dated 25.04.2023 of 'Deputy R.T.O. Thane' inspite of detailed observations recorded on 05.02.2024 and 19.03.2024 by stubbornly not acknowledging the fact that 'Stenographer (Lower Grade)' is standalone 'Single Post' attached individually to assist officers serving on the posts of '24 R.T.Os'. Hence, 'Prima-facie' it appears that Applicant had been laterally shifted by cryptic and ambiguous Order dated 25.04.2023 of 'Deputy R.T.O. Thane' to 'Old Building' due to some prejudice which is required to be unravelled and it is for this reason that 'Affidavit-in-Reply' has been sought from 'Transport Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Mumbai'.
- 7. The 'Balance of Convenience' at this stage therefore lies with the Applicant; who is accordingly permitted to occupy her earlier 'Work- Station'/ 'Desk' & 'Table' located in 'New Building' of 'R.T.O. Thane'; till 'Affidavit-in-Reply' is filed by 'Transport Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Mumbai' upon return from duty as 'E.C.I. Observer' for 'General Election Lok Sabha 2024'.

- 2. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that Applicant who is 'Forest Guard' had served in 'Panvel Forest Range' under 'Deputy Conservator of Forest, Panvel Forest Division' since 18.06.2019
- 3. Learned Advocate for Applicant further states that Applicant therefore came to be transferred by 'Chief Conservator of Forest (Territorial), Thane Circle, Thane' Order dated 25.08.2023 to post of 'Forest Guard' in 'Sudhagadh Forest Range' under 'Deputy Conservator Forest, Alibag Forest Division'.
- 4. Learned Advocate for Applicant then states that as per guidelines in 'Para B(2)(iii)' of 'Revenue and Forest Department' G.R. dated 22.05.2017 transfers of 'Forest Guard' should be effected from establishment of particular 'Forest Division' to 'Other Branches' such as 'Wildlife, Social Forestry etc. only after completion of two consecutive tenures in that 'Forest Division'.
- 5. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that even though Applicant came to be transferred out of jurisdiction of 'Deputy Conservator of Forest, Panvel Forest Division'; Applicant is now requesting for transfer to post of 'Forest Guard' back in 'Panvel Forest Range' under jurisdiction of 'Deputy Conservator of Forest,

Panvel Forest Division' as per option submitted on 11.05.2023 as there are 'Vacant Post' still available in 'Panvel Forest Range' and request is in conformity with guidelines in 'Para B(2)(iii)' of 'Revenue and Forest Department' G.R. dated 22.05.2017.

- 1. Heard Shri S. S. Dere, learned Counsel for the Applicants and Ms S. P. Manchekar, learned Chief Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. These Original Applications have been filed on 12.03.2024. Till now, three dates are given to learned CPO to obtain instructions as 'Interim Relief' is pressed by the Applicants.
- 3. The Applicants in both matters pray for quashing and setting aside the order dated 06.03.2024 issued by Respondent No.2 to the extent of fixing eligibility to post of 'Laboratory Scientific Officer (Malaria)' and further prays that Applicants be appointed on post of 'Laboratory Scientific Officer (Malaria)'.
- the Respondent No.1 issued an Advertisement on 21.05.2021 for the post of 'Laboratory Scientific Officer (Malaria) and other various posts of Public Health Department. However, as the paper was leaked, the Respondent No.1 cancelled the examination and carried forward all posts. In the Advertisement dated 21.05.2021, in Clause 2.2., the criteria for eligibility incorporated that the candidate should possess a requisite education qualification till the date of Publication of the Result. Thereafter, the Respondent No.1 in 15.03.2023 issued an Advertisement combined for the year 2021 & 2023 for various posts. In Clause 2.2 of Advertisement dated 15.03.2023, the requisite criteria for eligibility incorporates that candidate

should possess the requisite Educational Qualification by the last 'Date of Filling' of the Application Form.

- 5. The learned Counsel for Applicant further submits that Ms Rupali Bhosale is at Sr. No.479 and Ms Prashasha Rathod is at Sr. No.373 in the 'Merit List' published by Respondent No.1. Thereafter, on 22.02.2024, the Respondent No.2 sent a letter to Applicants for 'Document Verification'. At the time of 'Document Verification' on 26.02.2024, the Applicant were orally informed that they do not possess requisite Education Qualification as per Clause 2.2. of Advertisement dated 15.03.2023 as the 'Degree Certificate' should be before the last Date of Filling of the Application Form'
- 6. The learned Counsel for Applicants submits that last Date of Filling the Application Form was 18.09.2023 thereafter it was extended to 22.09.2023 and Ms Rupali Bhosale received an 'Internship Certificate' on 30.10.2023 and Ms Prashansa Rathod received her 'Internship Certificate' on 03.10.2023.
- 7. The learned Counsel for Applicants submits that after Documents Verification on 26.02.2024 and candidature of Applicants were rejected on 26.02.2024 by Selection Committee on the ground of ineligibility as per Clause 2.2 of Advertisement dated 15.03.2023. The Applicants therefore pray for direction to Respondents that they be appointed on post of 'Laboratory Scientific Officer (Malaria)'.
- 8. The learned Counsel for Applicants submits that case of the Applicants is covered under the ratio laid down by judgments in case of Ram Kumar Gijroya vs Delhi Sub. Services Selection Bd. & Anr: (2016) 4 SCC 754 and Dolly Chhanda vs Chairman, Jee & Ors.: 2004(4) SCT 546.
- 9. The office objection, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.
- 10. Issue notice before admission returnable on 07.05.2024.

- Heard Smt. Punam Mahajan, learned Counsel for the Applicant and Ms S. P. Manchekar, learned Chief Presenting Officer for the Respondents
- 2. The learned Counsel for Applicant submits that Applicant who is working as 'District Seed Certification Officer', Satara challenges Departmental Enquiry initiated by Respondent No.1 by Charge Sheet dated 21.01.2022 which was served by the District Superintendent Agricultural Officer, Satara by letter dated 03.02.2022.
- 3. The learned Counsel for Applicant further submits that incident pertains to the Year 2014 while Departmental Enquiry has been initiated belatedly in 2022.
- 4. The learned CPO for Respondents relies on Affidavit in Reply on behalf of Respondent Nos.1 & 2 dated 05.03.2024 and 03.04.2024 filed by Shri Ashok Gaikwad, Administrative Officer, in the office of Divisional Joint Director of Agriculture, Kolhapur Division, Kolhapur explaining the delay in institution of Departmental Enquiry.
- 5. The learned Counsel for Applicant seeks stay to Departmental Enquiry. The Applicant who is working as 'District Seed Certification Officer', Satara challenges Departmental Enquiry which was initiated on 21.01.2022 on grounds that incident and allegation are of the year 2014-2015 and 2016-2017. The learned Counsel submits that the Applicant who is now working as 'District Seed Certification Officer', Satara District

and it is alleged that Applicant in 2014-2015 had not acted as per Circular dated 25.05.2015 and have violated the same.

- Learned Counsel for Applicant then submits that Applicant was already transferred from Taluka Agricultural Officer, Khatav, District Satara by the Respondent No.1 by order dated 24.06.2014 and relieved on 26.06.2014 and posted as Taluka Agricultural Officer, Sangammer District Ratnagiri on 01.09.2014. Thus, it is not expected that Applicant did not act as per the procedure or guidelines laid down in Circular dated 25.05.2015. She further points out that there is a delay in initiating and conducting enquiry. Thereafter, the Enquiry Officer was appointed on 10.03.2023 i.e One Year after initiation of Departmental Enquiry. The 1st date of Departmental Enquiry was fixed on 18.06.2024. Under such circumstance, learned Counsel for Applicant prays that Departmental Enquiry be stayed.
- 7. Learned Counsel for Applicant relied on two Affidavits filed on 05.03.2024 and 03.04.2024 by Shri Ashok Gaikwad, Administrative Officer to explain the delay in institution of Departmental Enquiry. In the last Affidavit of 03.04.2024, the Chronology of Events is given from the nature of complaints to initiation of Departmental Enquiry.
- We have gone through both the Affidavits. It appears that the Departmental Enquiry was initiated on the basis of complaint filed by Shri Vilas Shankar Yadav before the Hon'ble Upa-Lokayukta. The charges in the Affidavit shows that report was submitted to Vigilance Squad on 24.08.2018 and then proposal was submitted Departmental Enquiry on 27.05.2021 Commissioner of Agriculture and Departemntal Enquiry was initiated on 21.01.2022. Thereafter proposal was submitted for appointing Enquiry Officer to the Competent Authority on 25.08.2022. The Supplementary Chargesheet was served by the Commissioner, Agriculture on 26.08.2022. Supplementary Chargesheet was served on Applicant and other officers on 09.03.2023 and on 10.03.2023, the 'Regional Departmental Enquiry Officer' was appointed as the 'Enquiry Officer'. The preliminary hearing of 18 delinquents' officers was fixed on -

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22.03.2024 and the next preliminary and regular hearing was fixed on 18.06.2024 at Regional Departmental Enquiry Officer, Pune.

- . Considering the above chronological events, we are of the view that delay is not properly explained on two Affidavits filed on 05.03.2024 and 03.04.2024. We failed to understand why there was more than One Year delay and no action was taken by the Agriculture Department in initiating Departmental Enquiry. The report of the Vigilance Committee was submitted to Commissioner, Agriculture on 24.08.2018 while the Departmental Enquiry was initiated on 21.01.2022 and 'Enquiry Officer' was appointed only on 10.03.2023. Thus, there is unexplained delay in initiation of Departmental Enquiry and in appointment of Enquiry Officer.
- 10. Under such circumstances, we grant interim stay as follows:
  - (i) The Departmental Enquiry is stayed till further orders qua the delinquent officer who is Applicant.
  - (ii) The enquiry in respect of other delinquent officers may proceed further on next preliminary and regular hearing on 18.06.2024 before Regional Departmental Enquiry Officer, Pune.

- 1. Heard Mr. K.S. Jadhav, learned Counsel for the Applicant.
- 2. In view of the objection raised by learned Counsel regarding appearance of Chief Presenting Officer or Presenting Officers, none appears for the Respondents today.
- 3. Learned Counsel has submitted that every Contempt is a Crime and as per the jurisprudence every crime is to be prosecuted by the State. Learned Counsel presses that Contempt Notice is to be issued on the Contempors.
- 4. We keep this issue pending at this stage. We are of the view that Contempt is always the matter between court and the Contemnor. It is such a weapon with the Court which is rarely used, if at all there is intentional or deliberate Contempt of its order. Hence, it is to be assessed by giving opportunity to the Respondents whether there is any intentional or deliberate Contempt. Hence, we issue notice to the Respondents. Respondents may appear through Counsel or in person. At this stage, we are not deciding this order which was raised in earlier order dated 18.04.2024 at paragraphs 3 & 4.
- 5. Contemnors may either appear in person or through Counsel or depute any other officer from Mantralaya, who is conversant with the file. We would like to verify whether it is intentional and deliberate on the part of these two Contemnors and then we will issue Contempt notice. However, the Contemnors are just to appear or engage the Counsel of their choice or depute any officer from the said Department.
- 6. The order dated 21.11.2013 passed in O.A.No.200/2022 is the subject matter of the Contempt. In paragraph 7 of the said order we have directed the Respondents to pay pension and gratuity to the applicant with interest as per Rules within the period of three months from the date of

the order and the Applicant was directed to cooperate the Respondents. As the order was passed on 21.11.2023 and three months time was given for compliance, the said period came to end on 21.02.2024. As no action is taken by the Government, Contempt Application is moved by the Applicant.

- 7. We make it clear that we do not want to answer or decide whether the C.P.O. or P.Os should appear on behalf of the Contemnors when they have acted in the Respondent capacity. However, C.P.O. and P.Os are at present not representing Contemnors in this matter.
- 8. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.
- 9. Issue notice before admission returnable on 30.04.2024.
- 10. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of C.A. Private service is allowed. Respondents are put to notice that the case may be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
- 11. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
- 12. By Hand delivery, speed post, courier notice to be served and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.
- 13. In case notice is not collected within seven days or service report on affidavit is not filed three days before returnable date, the Contempt Application shall be placed on board before the concerned Bench under the caption "for Dismissal" and thereafter on the subsequent date the Contempt Application shall stand dismissed.
- 14. Learned Counsel has submitted that he has already served copy of Contempt to the concern. However, on going through the copy of affidavit of service it seems that there is service on the Department which is wrong therefore we direct the Applicant to serve all the Contemnors personally.
- 15. At the request of learned Counsel, Adjourned to 30.04.2024.
