- 4. Ld. Advocate submits that applicants have completed three and half years of service and their posts are also counted in this vacancy chart. Ld. Advocate submits that applicants have secured more than the cut-off marks in the first list and after revised list cut-off marks was fixed at 67.5 marks and the applicants have gone below just by 1.25 marks. He submits that it is not the fault of the applicants and therefore termination will be injustice on them.
- We directed the office of Urban Development Department and the office of Ld. CPO to work out the matter by adjusting in view of the vacancies available. Ld. CPO informs that the applicants who are already working can be accommodated as per reservation in the vacancies submitted in the chart (supra). We also note that applicants have put in nearly three to three and half years in service and they have appeared in the examination conducted by the respondents and they were selected as they have secured more marks than the cut-off. However, the judgment and order dated 3.3.2020 was passed by the Nagpur Bench of this Tribunal in OA No.1025 of 2018 and answer of one question was declared wrong and thereafter the respondents declared revised list and the applicants naturally have secured 1.25 to 1.50 less marks and were not considered and so notice of termination were given. However, it is not the fault of the applicants. During three years of their service they naturally must not have applied for some other posts and therefore they have lost their opportunity of getting employment elsewhere. They have also passed the departmental examination in service.
- 6. Under such circumstances the OA No.207 of 2022 is allowed and the impugned termination notice dated 16.2.2022 is quashed and set aside. OA disposed off accordingly.
