ORDER

1. Heard Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Miss Savita Suryawanshi, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
2. The Applicant was removed from service on 17.12.2008. However, as per the directions of this Tribunal in OA No.98 of 2010 decided on 1.7.2014 (Exhibit C page 25 of OA), she came to be reinstated on 30.4.2015. The Respondents in the impugned order dated 6.9.2016 (Exhibit 'E' page 44) decided as under:


