#### ORDER

- 1. Heard Miss S.P. Manchekar, the learned Advocate for the Applicant and Miss N.G. Ghoad, the learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. Ld. PO states that he has received letter from Under Secretary of Public Health Department which is dated 20.8.2016 stating that:
  - (i) The order passed by this Tribunal in OA No.914 of 2013 was carried before the Hon'ble High Court by the State Government.
  - (ii) The order passed by the Hon'ble High Court dismissing writ petition of the State is dated 2.8.2016.
  - (iii) The Government has secured opinion from the concerned Government Pleader, who had represented the State in the



Hon'ble High Court who has opined in favour of filing SLP before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the officer concerned that is Under Secretary wants this information to be prougnt to the notice of this Tribunal.

- (iv) These facts be brought to the notice of the Tribuna.
- 3. This Tribunal asked the Ld. PO as to whether the Tribunal can have look at the letter. Ld. PO has tendered photocopy thereof.
- 4. Perusal of the order dated 20.8.2016 written to the Ld. PO by the department reveals the following:
  - (a) The Government is considering as to whether the judgment passed by this Tribunal and confirmed by the Hon'ble High Court be carried before the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
  - (b) The Ld. AGP, who has conducted the case in the Hon'ble High Court has opined in favour of approaching the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
  - (c) These facts i.e. (a) and (b) be brought to the notice of the Tribunal.
- 5. The Ld. Advocate for the applicant prays that she may be permitted to make submissions as regards the approach and attitude of the State Government, and states as follows:
  - (a) Like a private litigant State Government would always be free to take any case to logical conclusion which in fact is arrived due to the two concurrent judgments i.e. judgment by this Tribunal and judgment by Hon'ble High Court.
  - (b) The State Government would be definitely entitled to approach the Hon'ble Supreme Court if it is aggrieved by the judgments rendered in the OA and in the WP. However, the State ought to satisfy itself that there exist a case where the judgments to be challenged could be seen and shown to be contrary to law or otherwise bad.

- (c) Instead of taking a fair, judicious and dispassionate approach, the officers of the Government take the judgment which is adverse as a personal insult and by making an issue of prestige and ego keep on litigating at the cost of the State Government and by unreasonably vexing the Government servant to ordeals of litigation.
- 6. The Ld. Advocate for the applicant further submits as follows:
  - (a) Let the State Government take the luxury of fighting at the cost of State Exchequer, however, the applicant's interest needs to be protected because the Government machinery moves with snail's speed when it comes to granting any relief in accordance with the orders of the Tribunal.
  - (b) Therefore, a direction be given to the respondents to calculate and furnish the details of pecuniary benefits which will have to be paid to the applicant as and when the order passed by this Tribunal will have to be implemented.
  - (c) Applicant would move for suitable direction, once statement of calculation of money payable to the applicant is furnished.
- 7. This Tribunal has applied mind to the submissions of La. Advocate for the applicant. The submissions are sensible. Yet the right of the State Government to take a decision as to whether to accede to the Juagment of prefer to challenge it has to be recognized. However, request made by the learned Advocate for the applicant and recorded in foregoing para appears to be reasonable.
- 8. Previous experience as regards the manner in which the Government deals with and delays the matters, found in numerous cases is that the implementation of the order of the Tribunal, is delayed for years together. The delay is caused on the ground of challenge of the Tribunal's order before the higher forum, and after failure therein on the ground of governmental procedure.

- 9. Therefore, it would be appropriate to direct the respondents to calculate the benefits in the event the order passed by this Tribunai is to be implemented, prepare a statement of calculation of dues as payable, and furnish those to the applicant and before this Tribunal on next date.
- 10. S.O. to 18.10.2016.
- 11. Steno copy and hamdast is allowed. Ld. PO is airected to communicate this order to the respondents.

#### ORDER

- Heard Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Smt. Archana B.K., learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- This Misc. Application is filed for condonation of delay by the Applicant, who claims that the delay is of 5 months.
- Applicant is challenging order dated 6.9.2014, from the Respondent No.1, in which his request for grant of deemed date of promotion to the post of Deputy Director, Industrial Safety and Health from 14.5.2012, as against the actual date of promotion viz. 26.2.2014 was rejected. Learned Counsel for the Applicant stated that the Applicant could not challenge the impugned order earlier, as he was given charge of the post of Deputy Director, Industrial Safety and Health at Chiplun. Dist. Ratnagiri in addition to his own charge. As he was busy in his official work, he could not file the O.A within the time limit. The present O.A. was filed in February 2016, and there is a short delay of 5 months, which may be condoned.

- Learned Presenting Officer (P.O.) argued that a new office of the Deputy Director (Industrial Safety & Heartn) was opened at Chiplun, Dist. Ratnagiri on 30,7.2014. An officer from Pune was given additional charge of the post at However, the Applicant requested for transier to Chiplun and he was given additional charge of the post at Chiplun. Learned P.O contended that the Applicant was given the charge of the post of Deputy Director on his own request and the fact that he was holding additional charge or that post can not be a ground to justify delay in filing the O.A. Learned P.O. staed that during the period from August 2014 to October 2015, when the Applicant was holding charge of the post of Deputy Director at Chiplun, he hardly attended his office in Mumbai. Therefore his dlaim that he was 'extremely' busy holding two charges is not correct. Learned P.O. argued that the Applicant has not been able to point out any credible reason for delay in filing this O.A.
- 5. On carefully going through the material on record, it does appear that the Applicant is making too much of the fact that he was given additional charge of the post of Deputy Director at Chiplun. It appears that during that period, the Applicant was concentrating on Chiplun and he hardly did any work in Mumbai. However, it is also true that there is a short delay of 5 months in filing the present O.A. In the case of Esha Bhattacharjee Vs. Managing Committee of Reghunathpur Nafar Academy and Others reported in (2013) 12 SCC 649, Hon'ble S.C. has held that substantial justice should be considered paramount and pivotal and technican



considerations should not be given undue and uncalled for emphasis. In the present case, there is nothing to indicate that the Applicant can be said to be guilty of gross negligence in filing the O.A. A liberal, pragmatic, justice oriented and non-pedantic approach is required to be taken.

Considering the facts in totality, I am of the opinion that this is a fit case for condonation of delay. Misc. Application is accordingly allowed and delay in filing the O.A.No.164/2016 is condoned. There will be no order as to costs.
