- 1. Heard Smt Punam Mahajan, learned advocate for the Applicant and Shri A.J Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. In this Contempt Application, the applicant wants the implementation of the order dated 15.3.2021 passed by this Tribunal in O.A 180/2020, wherein the Respondents were directed to absorb the applicant on any of the equivalent post in Dairy Development Department, Pune, within one month from the date of the order. Thus, the order was expected to be complied with on or before 15.4.2021. The order was not complied with. Hence, the present Contempt Application was moved before this Tribunal.
- 3. By order dated 3.8.2021, we issued notice to the Respondents no 1 to 3 and also directed them to file affidavit in reply within three weeks.
- 4. Learned P.O files affidavit in reply dated 18.8.2021, of Mr Prashan P. Mohod, Regional Dairy Development Officer, Pune, in the office of Regional Dairy Development Office, Pune, Contemnor No. 3.



- 5. Learned P.O submits that the Respondent has issued the order on 9.8.2021 and complied the order of this Tribunal dated 15.3.2021. Learned P.O pointes out to the tabular form date wise stating that how the steps were taken for implementing the order of this Tribunal dated 15.3.2021 and the applicant was absorbed w.e.f 9.8.2021.
- 6. We have perused the affidavit in reply. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that as per the order of this Tribunal dated 15.3.2021, the applicant is to be absorbed from 15.3.2021 and not as per the order issued by the Respondents from 9.8.2021. We have also perused the explanation given by the Respondent no. 3. We make it clear that the Respondents have not challenged the order of this Tribunal before the Hon'ble High Court by filing Writ Petition. - 7. The applicant has filed the present Contempt Application after three months. We accept the delay on the part of the Respondents in taking decision. - 1. Heard Shri V.P Potbhare, learned advocate for the Applicant and Shri A.J Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. The present Misc Application is filed seeking condonation of delay in filing the Original Application. The cause of action according to the applicant arose in the year 2009 and the present Original Application is filed on 31.3.2021. Thus, there is a delay of 13 years in filing the Original Application.
- 3. Learned counsel for the applicant prays in the Original Application that the Respondents no 1 to 4 may kindly directed to consider and treat the period of his ad hoc services, i.e. from 30.8.1999 till the date of absorption, i.e. on 10.9.2009 as

continuous service and consider the seniority for grant of pensionary benefits.

- 4. There is a delay of 13 years in filing the present Original Application. Hence, we made a query to the learned counsel for the applicant to show good and satisfactory grounds to condone the delay of 13 years. The applicant had knowledge that he was absorbed in service on 10.2.2009 and his earlier ad hoc service from 30.8.1999 till 10.2.2009 was never regularized.
- 5. Learned counsel on our query for showing the reasons to condone the delay of 13 years, submitted that it is a continuous cause of action and therefore the delay of 13 years is to be condoned. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that his representations dated 11.2.2021, 23.2.2021, 19.3.2021 and 30.3.2021 are also not decided by the Respondents and not reply is given to the applicant.
- 6. As the learned counsel for the applicant could not point out any good and satisfactory reason to condone the long delay of 13 years, after going through the application, we also could not find good and satisfactory grounds justifying the delay of 13 years. The applicant had knowledge that he was absorbed and regularized in service on 10.2.2009 and his services from 30.8.1999 to 10.9.2009 was considered as ad hoc service.
- 7. Had the applicant made representation immediately and would have approached the appropriate Fora for his regularization, this delay could have been justified. However, in absence of any recourse taken by the applicant for seeking remedy for his grievance, we are unable to condone the delay of 13 years.

8. Hence, the Misc Application seeking condonation of delay of 13 years in filing the Original Application is dismissed. As the Misc Application is dismissed, the Original Application also stands dismissed.

- 1. Heard Shri S. B. Bhosale, learned Counsel for the Applicant and Shri A. J. Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. This is an application for condonation of delay for one year and six months caused in filing O.A. claiming consideration of past service for pension purposes.
- 3. The Applicant stands retired on 30.06.2017 as a Sweeper. Initially he was appointed as a part time worker and thereafter his services were regularized and ultimately he stands retired on 30.06.2017. His past services of nine years and five months was not considered for pension purpose. Therefore, he was filed the present O.A. along with application for condonation of delay.
- 6. In so far as the ground of condonation of delay are concerned, the Applicant contends that his daughter, aged 29 years died on 27.01.2018, and therefore, his family was in trauma. Thereafter, his son met with an accident on 29.04.2018 and was hospitalized for month. He also claims to have made representation on 01.10.2019 for consideration of past services but it was not responded. The Applicant has produced the copies of death certificate of Doctor, discharged certificate about hospitalization of his son and representation.

Tribunal's orders

- 7. Learned Counsel for the Applicant also placed reliance on the decision of the Hon'ble Bombay High Court in (2020) 4 Mah LJ 280 Anil Ramdas Pawar V/s Union of India wherein the delay of five years was condoned with observation that in the matter of condonation of delay the court should not adopt hyper technical view or mathematical approach which would be denial of justice in given case. Reference is also made to judgment of the Hon'ble High Court in (2013) 12 SCC 649 (Esha Bhattacharjee V/s. Managing Committee of Raghunathpur Nafar Academy & Ors) and AIR 1987 SC 1353 Collector, Land Acquisition V/s MST. Katiji & Ors wherein the principle that Court should adopt liberal approach while considering the application for condonation of delay has been reiterated.
- 8. Turning to the facts of the present case, the Applicant retired as a Sweeper and a is litigating for considering his past service for pension purpose. He has sufficiently explained that on account of untimely death of his daughter and accident of son, his family was in trauma, he could not avail services of lawyer within reasonable time. He made representation but it was not responded. He is claiming relief relating to pension which does not affect the interest of third party. He is from underprivileged section of society.
- 9. As such, considering all these aspects, I am of the view that reasons set out in the application has to be construed as sufficient cause for condoning the delay. Instead of rejecting O.A. on the point of limitation, it would be appropriate to decide his claim on merit so as to advance substantial justice. I am, therefore, inclined to condone the delay.
- 10. In view of above, delay is condoned. M.A.No.114/2020 is allowed with no order as to costs.
- 11. Learned P.O. is directed to file reply in O.A.
- 12. S.O. to 14.09.2021 for reply in O.A.

- 7. Learned Counsel for the Applicant submits that the matter was required to be placed before High Power Committee which is formed in view of Circular dated 12.02.2001 to consider the matters which does not fall in rules specifically. According to him, High Power Committee is empowered to exempt the Applicant from passing the said examination since he is already retired.
- 8. Learned Counsel for the Applicant further submits that he wants to verify whether there is any specific provision in Rule 1981 for relaxation in passing of examination since the Applicant is already retired from service.

Similarly he also relies on the order dated16.4.2019, passed by this Tribunal in O.A 975/2018, by which the Original Application was allowed and the Respondents were directed to release regular pension to the applicant.
- The applicant, Shri R.Y Kadam, has received the pension and pensionary benefits from 1995 till his date of retirement. However, learned counsel for the applicant argued that the applicant is entitled to pay fixation and pensionary benefits from 1986 when he was first appointed. Though, there were breaks in between his services were regularized and by order dated 16.4.2019 in O.A 975/218 the Tribunal has directed the Respondents to pay the benefits from 1986 and not from 1995. He has relied on the report of the Collector dated 28.1.2008. The Collector has also mentioned that the service of the applicant is to be considered from 1995. The order of the Tribunal dated 16.4.2019 in O.A 975/2018 was confirmed in W.P 7753/2019 and thus, the order of the Tribunal is not complied with by the Respondents.
- We have perused the report of the Collector, wherein the Collector has recommended regularization of services of the applicant and others. However, nowhere, he has stated expressly that the services are to be regularized from 1985, i.e. the date of their first appointment. Admittedly, there are many breaks. We called upon the learned counsel for the applicant to show a specific judicial order or a judicial finding stating that the service of the applicant is to be regularized from 1985 or 1986. Learned counsel for the applicant could not show us such specific finding.
- On the other hand, learned C.P.O pointed out to para 10 of order of this Tribunal dated 16.4.2019 in P.A. 975/2018, wherein it is observed as under:-

Tribunal's orders

"The Applicant was admittedly eligible for the appointment on the post of Junior Clerk. At the end of December, 1986, the appointment of the Applicant was cancelled in view of abolition of posts based on Zero Budget policy of State Government. However, later again, the Applicant was appointed by order dated 3.2.1994 and continued in service till retirement. Therefore, it would be appropriate to see the nature of posting of the Applicant from 1994 to 2017." (emphasis placed).

Thus, this being a Contempt Petition, we cannot go beyond the findings given and the order passed by this Tribunal in the Original Application.

In view of this, as the pay fixation and all pensionary benefits are given to the applicant from 1995 till the date of their retirement, nothing remains to be complied with by the Respondents.

- 2. Applicants are working as Sub Inspector (State Excise), which is a Group C, Non-Secretariat Post. They seek to challenge the transfer order dated 9.8.2021.
- Ld. Advocate for the applicants argued that these applicants are Class III employees in Non-Secretariat post and therefore entitled to a normal tenure of 6 years as per the provisions of Section 3(1) of the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act. 2005 (hereafter referred to as "the Transfer Act") and they have not completed their tenure. He further argues that the applicants were not covered by GR dated 9.4.2018 issued by the GAD as that GR is only applicable for employees who have completed their normal tenure. He pointed out that the applicants were transferred as per letter dated 25.5.2021 which lays down guidelines for transfer of Group A. B and C officers of the State Excise Department. He pointed out that a GR cannot override the Transfer Act and hence he prays for interim relief.
- 4. Ld. PO for the respondents argues that these are not mid-term transfer but general transfer as per letter dated

- 25.5.2021. She further pointed out that the applicants had submitted 10 options for transfer. Since these transfers were made by following guidelines laid down in letter dated 25.5.2021, approval of the higher authority was not required. She also states that a total of 150 officers were transferred on account of administrative exigencies. She also states that applicants have already been relieved and other officers have been posted in place the applicants in OA No.576 of 2021 and OA No.579 of 2021. Hence, interim relief may not be granted.
