The Applicant has challenged the transfer order dated 30.08.2021 whereby within a month he transferred from Khutal to Wangani *inter-alia* contending that the transfer order dated 30.08.2021 is in contravention of provisions of Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as 'Act 2005).
- 3. The perusal of record reveals that the Applicant was due for transfer while he was serving at Government Ashram School, Khutal, Tal. Murbad, Dist. Thane, and therefore, by order dated 09.08.2021 he was transferred to Government Ashram School, Mal, Tal. Murbad, Dist. Thane which was one of the options given by him. Accordingly, the Applicant came to be relieved from Khutal on 30.08.2021. However on 30.08.2021 when he went to Government Ashram School, Mal for joining, the Headmaster did not get him join stating that there is no vacancy. He accordingly reported the matter to Respondent No.4-Project Officer, Integral Tribal Development Project, Shahapur, Dist. Thane. Then again by order dated 30.08.2021, the Applicant posting is changed from Mal to Wangni which is under challenged in the present O.A.
- 4. Learned Counsel for the Applicant made a statement that in view of above situation, the Respondent No.4 orally directed the Applicant to rejoin at Khutal and accordingly he is again working at Khutal to avoid complication.
- s. As regard the transfer order dated 30.08.2021, learned Counsel for the Applicant has pointed out that once the Applicant is relieved from Khutal, there could not have been any change in the posting without following process of law namely placing of matter before Civil Services Board and approval of higher authority.

In the mean time both were acquitted in Criminal Case No.35/2007 by Judgment dated 15.01.2020.
- Co-delinquent Shri R.I. Ingole filed O.A. 4. No.287/2014 challenging order of dismissal which was allowed by the Tribunal by order dated 18.11.2015 and Applicant Shri R.I. Ingole has been reinstated in service.

- 5. In so far as the present case is concerned Shri Bharat M. Waje (Applicant's husband) didn't challenge the dismissal order. Later on he died on 06.07.2020. Thereafter the Applicant being his widow had applied for family pension as well as for appointment on compassionate ground which is turned down by the impugned order dated 26.07.2021 *inter-alia* stating that the Applicant's husband being dismissed from service she is not entitled for family pension or appointment on compassionate ground.
- 6. Learned Advocate for the Applicant fairly submits that deceased Shri Bharat M. Waje (Applicant's husband) didn't challenge dismissal order dated 17.09.2010. However, according to him since in the matter of co-delinquent order of dismissal is set aside, present Applicant is also entitled to the said benefit. This submission is totally misconceived and fallacious.
- 7. In so far as the Applicant's husband is concerned order of dismissal has attainted finality and since he was not party to O.A. No.287/2014 the Judgment in said O.A. will not enure for his benefit. It is Judgment in personam binding to party thereto only. Therefore the said Judgment is of no help to assistance of the Applicant. Only because co-delinquent has been reinstated in service it cannot be construed that said Judgment could enure for the benefits of Applicant's husband so as to grant retrial benefits or appointment on compassionate ground.
- 8. As such the order of dismissal of husband is still in force, and therefore, the claim of family pension or appointment on compassionate ground is totally unsustainable in law.
- 9. O.A. is thus totally misconceived and not maintainable, therefore matter is dismissed summarily without issuing notice.

- 3. Prima facie, we find that the MPSC by issuing the Circular dated 8.9.2020 has introduced a different criteria in respect of evaluation/assessment of the marks, specifically in respect of negative marking.
- 4. We are of the view that MPSC cannot change the method/procedure/rules of the examination including the evaluation of the Answer Sheets, once the advertisement is issued. MPSC is to be consistent with the Rules, which are mentioned in the advertisement or which are made public in the Notification before the Examination. Not following this position is contrary to the ratio laid down in the case of Madan Mohan Sharma & Anr Vs. State of Rajasthan & ors (2008) 3 SCC 724. The Circular dated 8.9.2020 therefore, cannot be made applicable retrospectively for the evaluation of the marks in the examination which is subject matter of challenge before us.
- **5**. We are of the view that if appropriate decision is not taken at this stage, then it may have more complications and chaotic situation after the Main Examination as more similarly situated candidates may challenge the result in future.
- **6.** Learned counsel for the applicants Mr Dere pointed out that the last date for filling up the form for the Main Examination is extended up to 26.9.2021, and it is to be further extended, if interim relief is not granted today. Learned counsel for the applicants further submits that by way of interim relief he also prays for revising the result of the Preliminary Examination so that the candidature of the applicant would not be questioned at the time of the Main Examination.

- 2. The learned Senior Counsel Mr. Apte submits that the State has moved the application under Section 25 of the Administrative Tribunals Act for transfer of T.A.No.1/2021 and T.A.No.2/2021 from Aurangabad Bench to Principal Seat at Mumbai.
- 3. The learned Counsel for the Respondents No.1 and 2 in both the matters submits that they need 10 days time to file affidavit-in-reply. The learned Counsel for the Applicant to serve the respective learned Counsel, Mr. Ajay Deshpande and Mr. Avinash Deshmukh.
- 4. The learned Counsel Mr. B.S. Shinde submits that the Respondents have also filed application for transfer of T.A.No.1/2021 and T.A.No.2 /2021 from Aurangabad Bench to Mumbai [P.T.O.
