This matter admittedly stands on the same platform of the case of Uttamrao P. Ugale (OA.890/2017 with MA.67/2019 decided on 4.2.2020) wherein the same issue of recovery and refund was dealt with. By judgment and order dated 4.2.2020 this Tribunal allowed the OA. The order of recovery dated 23.8.2016 was quashed and set aside and the respondents were directed to refund the amount which they have recovered from the applicant. The said order is applicable to the present state of facts where similar issue is raised. On this issue the ratio is laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of State of Punjab & Ors. Vs. Rafiq Masih (White Washer) (2015) 4 SCC 334 and it is settled law. However, it is found that in the affidavit in reply and specially in paras 20, 22 and 23 the person who prepared did not understand the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and also does not know how to read, interpret and make applicable the order passed by this Tribunal. I am surprised to come across the order passed by Ms. Ashwati Dorje, Director, Maharashtra Police Academy, Nashik, who has not understood the applicability of the ratio laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and specially in the case of Rafiq Masih (supra).

4. Ld. PO is directed to talk with Director, Maharashtra Police Academy and discuss the law on this point with her/him and come out with a proper answer in this matter.
