The Applicant has challenged communication dated 20.01.2021 issued by Office of Respondent No.2 thereby rejecting his request of grant of medical / commuted leave from 27.07.2017 to 27.09.2017 for 63 days.</p> <p>3. The Applicant contends that he was suffering from jaundice, and therefore, could not attend duty. He was attached to Malwani Police Station. He has produced station dairy extract (pg. 13 of P.B.) wherein it is stated that on 27.07.2017 the Applicant had informed to the Police Station on telephone that he is unwell and taking treatment in Nagpada Police Hospital. Police Station Malwani therefore issued sick pass to his brother. Thus, this entry in Police dairy makes it quite clear that the Applicant was unwell and he was given sick pass too.</p> <p>4. The Applicant has also produced fitness certificate issued by Police Hospital Nagpada 27.09.2017 certifying his fitness for duty (page 22 of P.B.)</p> <p>5. A.C.P., Malwani had also recommended for grant of medical / commuted leave to the Applicant as seen from page 18 of P.B.</p>

6. Despite aforesaid position, Respondent No.2 rejected leave solely on the ground that he has not produced any medical record which is contrary to the hospital record.

7. Indeed, before passing any such order Respondent No.2 ought to have seen sick pass given by Malwani Police Station and should have verified the record from Nagpada Police Hospital but without doing any such fair exercise he simply rejected the Application.

8. As such impugned order is arbitrary and unsustainable in law and liable to be quashed.

9. Matter needs to be remanded to Respondent No.2 to decide the request of the Applicant a fresh in light of sick pass and other documents.

10. In view of above, following order is passed.

a) Impugned order dated 20.01.2021 is quashed and set aside.

b) Matter is remanded back to Respondent No.2 to consider the claim of the Applicant medical / commuted leave afresh on the basis of sick note issued by Nagpada Police Station. He is also at liberty to call for record from Nagpada Police Hospital to verify the ailment / treatment of the Applicant.

c) The Applicant be also given opportunity to produce documents before passing order.

d) Above exercise be completed within two months from today.

e) No order as to costs.




