Nursing Colleges have vacancies against sanctioned number of seats for MSc. Nursing Course and, therefore, admission is given to the candidates who appeared before them on "first come first serve basis".

- 4. In order to get clarity about the policy of non-insisting on submission of application for admission without routing the same though cadre controlling authorities / sponsoring authorities in cases of in service candidates, assistance of the head of the concerned Nursing Institutes is necessary, who may assist the Tribunal by filing written submissions for which the applicants may get a written submission from them.
- 5. Learned C.P.O. and P.O. are yet to comply with orders passed by this Tribunal on 23.3.2022 and, therefore, time is granted for making compliance.
- 6. S.O. to 4.4.2022. During the intervening period the respective private Nursing Colleges / Institutes may not fill up the vacancy to the detriment of interest of applicants.
