- 2. The order dated 17.2.2023 whereby the respondent no. 3 had issued the order thereby directing the applicant to proceed on compulsory leave is challenged by the applicant in the present Original Application. The learned counsel for the applicant submitted that there is no such provision in the Maharashtra Civil Services Rules whereby a Government employee can be required to proceed on compulsory leave. The learned counsel submitted that in the identical matters previously this Tribunal has set aside such orders observing that there is no such provision in the M.C.S.R., which governs the services of the Government employees in the State.
- 3. The respondents have filed their affidavit in reply resisting the contentions raised in the application and the prayer made therein. Along with the affidavit in

reply the copies of proceedings of the Legislative Council are produced on record. It is the contention of the respondents that there were serious complaints against the present applicant, which have resulted in making the statement by the concerned Hon'ble Minister in the Legislative Council that the applicant will be sent on compulsory leave and the necessary enquiry will be conducted against him. From the documents which are produced on record it is revealed that one of the Members in the Legislative Council namely Amashya Padavi has raised a question about the conduct of the present applicant, wherein certain allegations are made against the applicant. It is alleged that the applicant was assigned the work of caste scrutiny when he himself has secured the Government employment on a false certificate. It is also alleged that he harassed the people from Scheduled Tribe for verification of their tribe It seems that elaborate discussion has certificates. taken place on question raised by the Member of Legislative Council and accordingly Hon'ble Minister has made a statement in the Legislative Council that the applicant will be directed to proceed on compulsory leave and further necessary action will be initiated against him. It is the contention of the learned P.O. that the impugned order has been passed in compliance of the

assurance given in the Legislative Council and, as such, interference is not warranted in the orders so passed.

- 4. I have duly considered the submissions advanced by the learned counsel appearing for the applicant and the learned Presenting Officer. I have gone through the documents, which are produced on record. It is true that some complaints were made against the applicants and the discussion took place in that regard in the Maharashtra Legislative Council. It is also undisputed that the concerned Minister on the floor of the Council assured the house that the applicant would be sent on compulsory leave and necessary actions will be taken against him.
- 5. After having perused the documents on record it is not the case that Legislative Council has taken any such decision. In fact, I am afraid that any such decision could have been taken by the Legislative Council. The question was to take action against the applicant. The Government has every authority to take appropriate action against the erring employees. However, all these actions must be in consonance with the service conditions and service rules which govern the services of the Government employees. If at all the Government is intending to take any action there are ways and means

for taking such action. However, as I have noted hereinabove the action which is not supported by any provision under M.C.S.R. cannot be taken. In none of the Service Rules which govern service conditions of the civil servants in the State contains any such provision which empowers the Government to send any employee on compulsory leave. In the circumstances, the impugned order cannot be sustained and deserves to be quashed and set aside. It is accordingly quashed and set aside. It is clarified that it would be open for the State Government to take any appropriate action against the present applicant permissible under M.C.S.R.

- A) This Original Application may kindly be allowed thereby holding & declaring the action of Resp. No. 1 of not including applicant's name in the Select List of Deputy Directors fit for promotion as Joint Directors in the Maharashtra Finance & Accounts Services as wholly unsustainable & untenable in law.
- B) This Original Application may kindly be allowed thereby directing the Resp. No. I to include applicant's name at appropriate place in the Select List of Deputy Directors held fit for promotion as Joint Directors in the Maharashtra Finance & Accounts Services on the basis of meeting of the Departmental

- C) This Original Application may kindly be allowed thereby further directing the Resp. Nos. 1 and 2 to take all the consequential steps and promote the applicant from the cadre of Deputy Directors to the cadre of Joint Directors in the Maharashtra Finance & Accounts Services alongwith all the 33 officers held fit for said promotion in the meeting of the Departmental Promotion Committee/Establishment Board held on 22/02/2023.
- (D) This Original Application may kindly be allowed thereby further directing the Respondents to extend to the applicant all the consequential service benefits to which he would become entitled in view of grant of Prayer Clauses "A" to "C" in his favour.

 - Pending the admission, hearing and disposal of this Original final *Application the* Resp. Nos. 1 and 2 may kindly be directed to keep one post of Joint Director inMaharashtra Finance & the Accounts Services from the Aurangabad Revenue Division vacant and not to fill up the same."
- 5. Keeping one post vacant from the Revenue Division, Aurangabad at this stage when it is not known for which division the applicant choice may be considered in case the Original Application is allowed, it is just and proper to direct the respondents not to allot Revenue Division till filing of affidavit in reply by the respondents.
- 6. Learned C.P.O. assures to submit affidavit in reply within 15 days time."
- 4. The original applicant has challenged exclusion of his name for promotion to the post of Joint Director, Maharashtra Finance and Accounts Services and Departmental Promotion Committee held on 22.02.2023.

- 5. Affidavit in reply is filed on behalf of original respondent nos. 1 to 3 in the O.A. At the same time, the present M.A. No. 142/2023 is taken out by the original respondents seeking to vacate the interim relief order contending that due to the said order entire process of promotion is being held up. Moreover, one of the Officers is retiring on superannuation on 31.3.2023 and other two Officers are retiring by 30.4.2023.
- 6. After having considered the submissions of both the sides, we find that in the list of 33 candidates being selected for the post of Joint Director, Maharashtra Finance & Accounts Services, the name of the applicant does not appear. It is the contention of the respondents in their affidavit in reply that the name of the applicant was not considered for promotion due to pending criminal prosecution against him. The learned C.P.O. in oral submissions submitted that sealed cover procedure is followed in the case of the applicant.
- 7. Further, it is a fact that as against total vacant posts of 35, names for 33 posts are being selected and because of interim order of this Tribunal, there

is difficulty in giving appointments on promotional posts.

- 8. It is pertinent to note here that by interim order the respondents are directed not to allot Revenue Division till filing of the affidavit in reply.
- 9. Considering the contentions raised by the respondents in their affidavit in reply, in our considered opinion, if the interim relief order is modified to the extent only of keeping one post vacant subject to accommodation of the Officers at Sr. Nos. 1 to 8 in the select list dated 24.2.2023 (Annex. A-6), who are stated to be senior to that of the applicant in the seniority list as per their preference of choices of Revenue Divisions until further orders, the interest of both the parties to the O.A. can be protected. Thereby no irretrievable prejudice would be caused to either of the parties. Hence, it is ordered accordingly.

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(b) By a notification dated 04.03.2020, M.P.S.C. published advertisement in clause 3 of the said advertisement with following effect as shown in tabular form.

As per dt. 28.02.2020	100	200	100	40
As per amended schedule of exam notified on 04.03.2020	100	400	100	40

- (c) Applicant is aggrieved by above revised scheme of exam by increasing weightage for written test. He has contended that the aforesaid amendment is prejudicial to the interest of the applicant. Learned Advocate for the applicant has cited judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court in
- (i) Appeal (Civil) 1492 of 2000, Maharashtra State Road TPT. Corporation & Ors. Vs. Rajendra Bhimrao Mandve & ors., delivered on 20.11.2001 and (ii) Civil Appeal No. 9482 of 2019 (Arising out of Special Leave Petition (Civil) No. 12245 of 2019, Dr. (Major) Meeta Sahai Vs. State of Bihar & Ors.

- (d) Applicant has also contended that amended clause 3 of the aforesaid advertgisemnt No. 05/2020 issued by respondent No.2 is in violation with scheme of exam published by M.P.S.C. through it's document entitled "महाराष्ट्र दुय्यम सेवा अराजपत्रित, गट-ब परीक्षेची परीक्षा योजना" as mentioned in cause 10 of the said Advertisement.
- On the other hand, learned C.P.O. has (e) contended that impugned amendment in the said advertisement had been notified at the very initial stage of the recruitment process and therefore, cannot be said to be in compromise with the of equal opportunity to principles all candidates. Learned C.P.O. also contended that the General Guidelines issued by MPSC set out the manner in which gap in scheme of exam can be filled but those guidelines do not restrict or prevent incorporation of any different scheme of exam to meet job requirements. He has also contended that the case law cited by the Learned Advocate for the applicant have different ratio and therefore, are not applicable in the present case.
- (f) We have also taken note of the fact that the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Bombay has vide it's judgment dated 10.01.2023 in W.P.No.

311 of 2023, observed in para Nos. 18 & 19 as follows:-

- "18. Merely because the original scheme of consideration of marks obtained in physical test is restored, there is no reason for the petitioners to feel aggrieved. The revised marking pattern for physical test would be uniformly made applicable to all candidates participating in the selection process. It cannot be said that the decision of the Commission is arbitrary. In our view, therefore, the Tribunal has not committed any error in dismissing the Original Application of Petitioners.
- 19. Petition filed by the petitioners is thus devoid of merits, the same is dismissed without any order as to costs. Rule stand discharged."
- In considered opinion, general (g) our guidelines issued by M.P.S.C. as mentioned in para 10 of the said advertisement entitled as "महाराष्ट्र दुख्यम सेवा अराजपत्रित, गट-ब परीक्षेची परीक्षा योजना", is facilitative in nature and it is in no way, restrictive so far as M.P.S.C's. right to incorporate different scheme of exam is concerned at the initial stage itself; so long as the same is not ultra vires to Article 14 and 16 of the Constitution of India or any statute or Rule framed by Competent Authority. We are also of considered opinion that the upward revision in total examination for main exam at initial stage of recruitment does not prejudice any segment of candidates and reason given for incorporating such

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amendment appears to be in interest of Police service in view of changing job requirements. Hence, the following order:-

ORDER

- (A) Original Application No. 69-A of 2023 is dismissed being devoid of merit.

It is also contended that the applicant has hardly served for one and half year at Ahmednagar and has been transferred before completing the ordinary tenure of three years on the said post.
- 3. Request is opposed by the learned P.O. The impugned order only speaks that the applicant has been transferred on administrative grounds. It is true that in the order of transfer it is not expected that the Government shall elaborate the circumstances which made the Government to direct the transfer of the concerned employee. At this juncture, for want of instructions learned P.O. is also unable to state as to

under what circumstances the applicant has been transferred before completing his ordinary tenure at the present posting.

- 4. In the circumstances, I deem it appropriate to issue notice to the respondents, returnable on 06-04-2023. Point of interim relief is kept open. If the reply is not filed on the given date, the request for interim relief will be considered even without reply of the respondents.
- 5. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
