- 2. The Applicant has challenged suspension order dated 26.12.2022 whereby the Applicant is suspended in contemplation of D.E. invoking Rule 4(1)(a) of M.C.S. (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1979 and his Headquarter is kept at Aurangabad. At the time of suspension the Applicant was Special Auditor, Class 1, Co-operative Societies (Sugar), Pune.
- 3. Learned Advocate for the Applicant sought interim relief for change of Headquarter in view of circulation dated 19.03.2008 issued by Government specifically instructing the Departments that where Government servant is suspended Headquarter should normally be assume to be his last place of duty. It is only in case of request of change of Headquarter by employee in that event Headquarter can be changed by competent authority if it is satisfied that such course would not put Government into any extra expenditure like T.A. etc. or any other complexion.
- 4. In present case the Applicant was at Pune and his Headquarter is kept at Aurangabad though he has not made request. As such change of Headquarter is totally impermissible. Indeed, it would result into extra expenditure which is to be avoided as clarified in Circular dated 19.03.2008.
- 5. It is really disgusting that the Tribunal has come across several such cases of change of Headquarter and Tribunal passed order in terms of Circular dated 19.03.2008 keeping Headquarter at the last place of Change of Headquarter are mechanically passed by

Government. Respondent No. 2 – Principal Secretary, Cooperation Department is therefore required to take note of this issue.

- 6. When the above aspect is brought to the notice of P.O. she expresses her inability to justify change of Headquarter. She could not point out any Circular contrary to the Circular dated 19.03.2008. All that she submits that Government is passing orders.
- 7. Tribunal hope and trust that such instances would not occur again else it would be viewed seriously.
- 8. For aforesaid reasons order of suspension dated 26.12.2022 to the extent of Headquarter is quashed and set aside. The Applicant Headquarter be kept at Pune.
- 9. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.

- 2. Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that pursuant to order dated 18.1.2023 passed by this Tribunal the applicant has filed affidavit dated 23.1.2023 before the Deputy Director. In the said affidavit dated 23.1.2023 he has mentioned about the earlier affidavit dated 26.9.2006 filed before the Deputy Director. Ld. Advocate submits that applicant is 77 years old.
- 3. Shri V.A. Dhotre, Deputy Secretary, Finance Department is directed to remain present today in the Court.
- 4. A query is made by Finance Department directing the applicant to bring the certificate of Superintendent of Police. Under Secretary is called upon to explain the certificate of which Superintendent of Police is required and under what provisions the said certificate is asked for.

We called upon the Finance Department to point out the rule from MCS or in GR/Circular issued by the Government in Finance Department or GAD that such certificate of Superintendent of Police is required. The applicant has submitted his affidavit dated 23.1.2023 wherein in para 4 he has mentioned that no criminal case was registered against him during the period of absenteeism and he was not employed during that period. This affidavit is sufficient.
- 8. It is necessary to make clear to the respondent-State especially Finance Department and GAD that no Superintendent of Police can give such certificate because Superintendent of Police of a particular district has knowledge and is responsible for record of the criminal in that particular district only. Moreover, a person can go out of Maharashtra or out of country and commit offence. So it cannot be made applicable to any Superintendent of Police.
