#### ORDER

1. At the time of hearing, the interpretation of the G.R dated 29.5.2019 in respect of reservation for the Disabled persons is argued by both the learned counsel for the applicant and the learned C.P.O. Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the roster which is mentioned in the G.R should have been made applicable from 1995, when the Act came into existence. In view of clause 8 of the said G.R, we want both the parties to assist us. Therefore, we call upon the Respondent-State to furnish the data of the vacancies of the post of Joint Director from 1995 till

2021 within three weeks. The said Data is to be furnished to the learned counsel for the applicant and the learned counsel for the applicant is directed to show how the roster should be given effect as per clause of 8 of the G.R dated 29.5.2019.

- 2. However, on 7.9.2021, learned C.P.O has made statement that the scrutiny of the applications is going and it will take nearly three weeks and hence nothing is going to happen for three weeks. Considering the statement made by the learned C.P.O, no need to take up the application for interim relief at this stage.
- 3. Resultantly, till today the selection process of the post of Joint Director is stalled. We are of view that such important posts especially in the Medical field are not to be kept vacant and the selection process should not be stopped.
- 4. Therefore, we direct the M.P.S.C to go ahead with the selection process for appointment to the post of Joint Director and the appointment to the said post by recruitment will be subject to the outcome of this Original Application. We further direct M.P.S.C to make it clear to all the candidates about this particular condition. The applicant is permitted to participate in the said selection process.

- 1. Heard Mr. R.B. Gaikwad, learned Advocate a/w. Mr. V.B. Dhage, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Ms. Archana B.K., learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. The learned Advocate Mr. Gaikwad states that the applicant has sought admission in M.Sc Psychiatric for the year 2021-23 in Respondent no.4. In the selection list for the post-graduation course she stood 2<sup>nd</sup> in the first selection list in the said college. However, she was not able to complete the necessary formalities in time as she was not relieved by Respondent No.2 in time. She sought paid study leave to complete the said course as per G.R. dated 17.04.2014 and as she was not relieved in time, she took provisional admission in Respondent No.5 college which is a private college for the post of obstetrics/gynecology (OBGY).
- 3. However, she did not inform Government before taking admission in Director, Wanless Hospital, College of Nursing, Miraj for OBGY course. She has now already completed one year. She has given an undertaking to the Department stating that she will complete the course in M.Sc. Nursing in OBGY utilizing her Earned Leave.
- 4. This is a peculiar case because the Government policy clearly states that admission to a Private Nursing course is not allowed by the Public Health Department vide circular dated 07.02.2020 However, looking at the peculiar circumstances of

the case as the applicant was eligible to get admission in a Government institute in view of her rank in the merit-list and it was not possible for her to get admission, because of the delay in reliving her, she prays that she may be allowed to finish the M.Sc. course as she has already completed 1 year utilizing her balance Earned Leave approx. 88 days and rest of the leave is to be treated as balance earned leave subject to verification.

5. In view of the special circumstances of the case and looking into the fact that she was a meritorious student who was eligible to get admission in a Government the College for M.Sc., we partially allow the O.A. The Department should grant her permission to complete the remaining one year of her M.Sc as a special case utilizing her balance earned leave (subject to verification) and the remaining days are to be treated as unpaid leave. Applicant is further directed to join back to Government service on the next day after completion of her final M.Sc. examination.

- 1. Heard Smt. Punam Mahajan, learned Counsel for the Applicant and Shri A. J. Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. The Applicant retired as Pharmacist on 31.12.2018 but his retiral benefits are not paid except provisional pension for some time.
- 3. Learned Counsel for the Applicant submits that there is no D.E. or criminal prosecution at the time of retirement and as such there was no legal hurdle to withhold the retiral benefits. According to her, the issue was about regularizing absence for some period from 04.06.2010 to 31.05.2012.
- 4. Indeed, as per provisions of Section 122 of Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1982, the process of preparation of pension papers ought to have been completed at least before six months of the retirement of the  $\alpha$  Government servant so that service book is updated in all respect. Section 122 of MCS (Pension) Rules reads as under:-

"Completion of pensions papers: The Head of Office shall complete Part I (and Part III) of Form 6 not later than six months, before the date of retirement of the Government servant."

- 5. As pointed by learned Counsel for the Applicant that the Respondent No.2 Director, Commissionerate of Heath Services, Central Building, Pune had written letter dated 23.11.2020 to Respondent No.5 Chief Medical Officer, State TB and Demonstration Centre, Pune to take all necessary steps to release retiral benefits of the Applicant but till date no action is taken.
- 6. Since the Applicant retired from the establishment of Respondent No.5, it was his obligation to complete the pension process and to ensure the payment of retiral benefits.
- 7. Learned P.O. is directed to take instruction on phone as to why retiral benefits are not paid.
- 8. The matter be kept in the afternoon session.

- 9. The matter is taken in the afternoon session. Learned P.O. on instructions states that the issue of leave for the period from 04.06.2010 to 31.05.2012 is not yet decided and after the decision thereon steps will be taken to release the retiral benefits to the Applicant.

- 14. If the Applicant felt aggrieved by the same, he may avail further legal remedy.
- 15. The Respondents are further directed to pass further appropriate orders about the retiral benefits of the Applicant in accordance to rules within two weeks from the date of decision on the issue of leave and the monetary benefits be released accordingly.
- 16. The Applicant is at liberty to redress his grievance on interest independently.
