2. Heard Mr. M.D. Lonkar, learned Advocate after he filed copy of letter dated 03.06.2024 of 'Solicitor-cum-Joint Secretary' of 'Law and Judiciary Department' regarding engagement as 'Special Counsel' for 'Public Health Department' in 'O.A. No.665/2024'.
3. Learned Advocate for Applicant again contended that 'Head Quarter' of Applicant after 'Suspension' on 21.05.2024 from post of 'Health Officer, Pune Municipal Corporation' which has been fixed as 'Nandurbar'; is contrary to guidelines in 'G.A.D. Circular dated 19.03.2008'. Therefore 'Head Quarter' of Applicant should be fixed as 'Pune'.
4. Learned Advocate for Applicant emphasized that this 'G.A.D. Circular dated 19.03.2008 has been interpreted and upheld in O.A. No.27/2023 dated 09.01.2023 and O.A. No.1093/2022 dated 11.11.2022.
5. Learned 'Special Counsel' for Respondent thereupon states that Applicant has no right as such to seek 'Head Quarter' to be fixed as 'Pune' consequent to 'Suspension' on 21.05.2024 from post of 'Health Officer, Pune Municipal Corporation'. Further he contended that this O.A. No.665/2024 which relates to 'Suspension' of Applicant is not maintainable with

6. The O.A. No.665/2024 is required to be initially heard on the issue of maintainability as contended by 'Special Counsel' for 'Public Health Department'. However in the meanwhile it is imperative for 'Public Health Department' to provide information about nature of complaints against Applicant which appear to relate to earlier tenures when Applicant was serving on posts of (i) 'District Health Officer, Z.P. Satara' and (ii) 'District Health Officer, Z.P. Pune' prior to joining on 'Deputation Post' of 'Health Officer, Pune Municipal Corporation'. The 'Public Health Department' to further provide information as to whether these complaints against Applicant had been enquired into earlier and what were the findings thereof and if not what were the reasons thereof for delay, as also in either case produce relevant 'File Notings' & 'Case Papers'; since there is no other way to ascertain the 'Compelling Reasons' which resulted in formation of 'Three Member - Enquiry Committee' under 'Joint Secretary Public Health Department' by 'letter dated 29.04.2024' addressed to 'Commissioner Health Services & Director National Health Mission, Mumbai'.

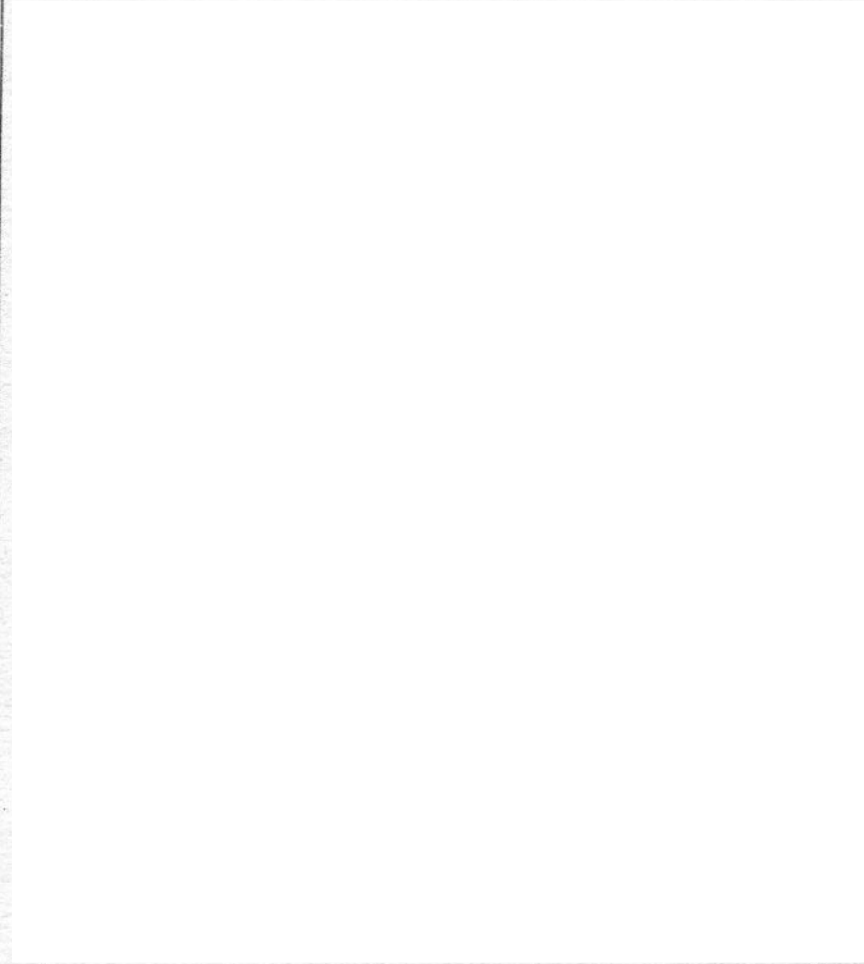


