Nos.327, 328 & 329/2017 ~~was~~ ^{was} disposed of. A part of that order is being reproduced herein below:-

"Although in strongly opposing this application, the learned P.O. referred to the fact that the delay is long and periods are different in each one of these OAs. I find that course of action that I adopted in deciding the **M.A. No.627/2015 in O.A. No.1116/2015 (Shri M.S.A.J. Inamdar V/s State of Maharashtra), dated 17.01.2017** will surely have to be adopted herein as well. Further it is clear from the circular issued by the Government in Law and Judiciary Department, dated 02.08.2017 and it is a good authority to hold that these applicants will be entitled to the same relief that the others got. Further the general principle that applications such as these must be approached liberally also inform my mind. The delay in each one of these matters are hereby condoned. The applicants and the office of this tribunal shall take all steps necessary to get the OAs listed before the appropriate bench for disposal according to the law.
