Thereafter, again M.A 344/2020 was filed seeking extension of six months in December, 2020. It was not decided as it is decided today. That time is also consumed as on June, 2021. Thereafter for a period of one year the Respondent-State has not implemented the order of the Tribunal nor approached the Hon'ble High Court challenging the order of the Tribunal.
- 4. The excuse given by the Respondent-State that various Original Applications are filed in different Benches of the Tribunal at Mumbai, Nagpur and Aurangabad on the same issue challenging the seniority list
- 5. We are of the view that this stand cannot be acceptable when there is no stay. The Respondent-State is bound under obligation to take steps for compliance of the order. As per instructions from the learned C.P.O it appears that the promotion was wrongly given to nearly 112 Civil Engineering Assistants to the post of Junior Engineer. The said promotion as per the order of the Tribunal was given as a deviation of the rules. Hence, it is obligatory on the part of the Respondent-State to issue notice of reversion to all these 112 Junior Engineers who were wrongly promoted by way of compliance of the order of this Tribunal.

- 2. Pursuant to order dated 20.6.2022 the respondents have filed affidavit dated 4.7.2022 of Dr. Ashok N. Karanjkar, Commissioner, ESIS, Mumbai.
- 3. Ld. CPO relies on paras 3 & 5 of the affidavit dated 15.6.2021 filed by Shri Appaso Balapa Dhulaj. Commissioner, ESIS, Mumbai wherein it is stated that footfall of the patients is reduced considerably, therefore presently there is no additional requirement of staff nurses than existing. Therefore, Government does not want to fill up the vacancies. At this stage the Ld. CPO further submits that Government has not given appointment *to other temporary nurses in place of the applicants.
- 4. Ld. Advocate for the applicants submits that order dated 30.6.2015 of the Tribunal is not complied with. The Ld. Advocate submits that bonded nurses who were working along with applicants, who are on temporary basis, were given appointment and their services is regularized. This is contrary to the order of the Tribunal. Hence, this is contempt.
- 5. This contempt is directed against the judgment and order dated 30.6.2015 passed in OA No.1125 of 2013 and implementation is demanded. The applicants are admittedly working on temporary basis as Nurses. Some of the applicants had earlier filed W.P. No.1083/2000 which was dismissed on 20.7.2000 and the Hon'ble High Court granted interim relief that services of the applicants/petitioners shall not be liable to be terminated till regularly selected

candidates are made available. The Tribunal while passing order dated 30.6.2015 has relied on paras 4 & 5 of the order in W.P. The Tribunal has passed order dated 30.6.2015 in consistent with the order of the Hon'ble High Court.

- 6. We are informed by Ld. CPO that in 2017 the department recruited 30 regular staff nurses in ESIS Hospital. Solapur and accordingly appointment order dated 29.11.2017 was given to those 30 staff nurses. Ld. CPO informs that Govt. has not appointed any other temporary staff nurses like the present applicants and no other staff nurses are replaced like the applicants in service and thus the respondents have complied with the order passed by this Tribunal and so also the Hon'ble High Court.
- 7. Ld. Advocate submits that there is violation of the order of the Hon'ble High Court because bonded nurses were appointed and present applicants were not appointed. These submissions are not correct because on query we are informed by Ld. CPO that bonded nurses have participated in the recruitment process and appeared in the examination and they were selected on merit and therefore they were recruited. While the applicants did not appear in the recruitment process as they are not bonded nurses. They should have taken legal recourse which was open to them.
- 8. Thus, we are of the view that orders of this Tribunal as well as Hon'ble High Court are complied with. CA disposed off accordingly.
