- 2. The Applicant has filed the O.A. simply for direction to the Respondents to allow him to join at Buldhana in terms of transfer order dated 28.06.2023 passed by the Government.

As such, the Applicant is left in abeyance and, therefore, he has filed the present O.A. for direction to the Respondents to allow him to join at Buldhana and to continue the work.

- 5. This matter was taken up for admission in morning session and learned P.O. is directed to take instructions as to why the Applicant is not allowed to work at the place he is transferred by the Government. In afternoon session, all that learned P.O. stated that because of some ongoing project at Buldhana for its completion, the concerned person was continued at Buldhana. However, in this behalf, perusal of record reveals that the post of Superintending Engineer, Buldhana is vacant for long time and additional charge was only given to one Shri Ram Hajare, Executive Engineer. Thus, the fact remains that the post of Superintending Engineer, Buldhana is vacant. It is for this reason, the Applicant is transferred from Pune to Buldhana.
- 6. It appears that Shri Ram Hajare, Executive Engineer who is holding additional charge of Superintending Engineer does not want to part with the charge. Strikingly, transfer order was passed on 28.06.2023 and the order of additional charge in favour of Shri Ram Hajare is passed by the Government on 18.08.2023 which is nothing but attempt to keep the Applicant in abeyance without any lawful reasons.
- 7. Admittedly, the transfer order dated 28.06.2023 is in force and has not been modified by the Government. This being so, the transfer order dated 28.06.2023 passed by the Government is required to be implemented since the Applicant is left in abeyance for more than two months.
- 7. In view of above, nothing is to be adjudicated in the present matter and O.A. deserves to be disposed of with suitable directions. Hence, the following order:-

ORDER

- (A) The Original Application is disposed of with directions to the Respondent No.1 to implement the order dated 28.06.2023 and get the Applicant joined within a week.
- (B) No order as to costs.

The Applicant has challenged the transfer order dated 10.08.2023 whereby she is transferred from Ratnagiri to Pune inter-alia contending that though she was due for transfer, she is not transferred in general transfer of 2023 but later transferred by impugned order dated 10.08.2023 without considering options given at the time of general transfer.
- Admittedly, the Applicant has completed normal tenure at Ratnagiri and she was due for transfer in general transfer of 2023 which were required to be issued in the month of April and May. However, she is transferred by order dated 10.08.2023 which partakes character of mid-tenure transfer. No special reason has contemplated under Section 4(5) of Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 is forthcoming. Nobody is posted in place of the Applicant at Ratnagiri.
- In view of above, impugned transfer order dated 10.08.2023 is prima-facie not in consonance of Transfer Act, 2005 and liable to be stayed.
