

In the present O.A., the Applicant has challenged the transfer order dated 13.09.2019 whereby the Applicant was transferred from the post of Assistant Commissioner (Drugs), Kolhapur to Assistant Commissioner (Drugs), Bhandara on administrative ground. 3. Learned Counsel for the Applicant submits that the impugned transfer order is not in consonance with the provision of Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as 'Act 2005) since the same is not approved by the Hon'ble Chief Minister as required under 'Act 2005'. 4. Whereas, learned P.O. has tendered the file for perusal of the Tribunal and submitted that the Civil Services Board recommended the transfer of the Applicant to Sangali and the same was approved by the Hon'ble Chief Minister. However, later serious complaints against the Applicant pertaining to her functioning at Kolhapur were received that she should not posted at Sangali which is close to Kolhapur. He has pointed out that there are complaints of Chemists, Hon'ble Minister and Hon'ble M.P. and posting was changed to Bhandara. 5. However, perusal of file reveals that there was no approval of Hon'ble Chief Minister for posting of the Applicant at Bhandara. Learned P.O. fairly concedes that the Applicant being Class-I officer, the approval of Hon'ble Chief Minister was necessary.

True, there seems to be some complaints against functioning of the Applicant but it being mid-term transfer, there has to be compliance of Section 4(5) of 'Act 2005' which requires approval of the competent authority which is Hon'ble Chief Minister in the present matter. Thus, prima-facie, the transfer order is bad in law.
7. In view of above, interim relief is granted in terms of prayer clause 10(a) of the O.A.
8. Liberty is granted to the Respondents to issue fresh order, if deem it necessary, in accordance to law.
9. Issue notice before admission returnable on 23.10.2019 as to why interim relief should not be made absolute.
