- The applicant who is a Medical Officer challenges order dated 18.9.2024 passed by respondent no.2 transferring her from Regional Mental Hospital, Yerwada, Pune to Rural Hospital, Saswad, Tal. Purandar, District Pune. Ld. Advocate for the applicant states that applicant was transferred to Mental Hospital, Pune on 11.10.2017 and as she has put in 7 years she was due for transfer. The applicant challenges the transfer order on the ground that applicant is 90% disable and relies on the disability certificate dated 20.8.2015 for Physical Impairment. She is having disability of Post Traumatic Paraplegia 90% and she has produced Disability Certificate issued on 20.8.2015 by Sassoon General Hospital, Pune. She has also produced Unique Disability ID issued by Govt. of India on 3.10.2022 which is valid permanently. He relies on the GRs. dated 15.4.2004 and 15.12.2004 wherein it is expressly directed to all the departments that the difficulties of the disabled Government servants are to be considered and directions given about the transfer of such government servants to near their residence are required to be followed scrupulously. The applicant is staying at Sinhgad Road, Pune. The applicant is a single parent having teenager daughter studying in MIT College, Kothrud, Pune.
- 3. Ld. Advocate for the applicant states that applicant is not challenging the fact of transfer but the place where she is transferred is challenged. She has given four options viz. (i) Police Dispensary, Swargate (ii) Bandokhala Leprosy Hospital, Kondhwa (iii) Nagari Kutumb Kalyan Kendra, Bhavani Peth and (iv) Police Dispensary, Shivajinagar.
- 4. Ld. PO submits that the competent authority to transfer the applicant is the Principal Secretary, Public Health Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai and the said authority is not made party respondents in the above OA.

Further, officers falling in the category (home district/ 3 years + criteria and due to retire within 6 months) if holding an election related post mentioned in para 5, shall be relieved of that charge and not be associated with any election related duty. It is, however, reiterated that such retiring officer need not be transferred out of the district."

- 5. Thus, in view of the above clause, in case of Applicant the six months period is counted from 31.05.2024 to 31.11.2023, hence, applicant does not fall in sub clause (vi) of Clause 6 of guidelines dated 31.07.2024. Learned Counsel has submitted that Applicant is holding the election related post. He has submitted that the applicant is ready to accept non-functional post. He has also submitted that there are 13 functional posts vacant in Thane District and Applicant can be considered for the same.

Learned Counsel has further submitted that though the applicant has put in 4 years she was appointed as Sector Officer by order dated 12.08.2024 which was after the issuance of guidelines, but before the order of transfer was passed which is dated 20.09.2024. Learned Counsel has submitted that there was an error committed by the then Commissioner Pimpri Chinchwad. He explains that the applicant prior to 31.09.2024 was given the Additional Charge of the Administrative Officer i.e. Notified post for a period of 10 days only (Zone A) and her regular post as Administrative Officer/ Social Development Officer, (but not in Zone A), Pimpri Chinchwad Municipal Council is not a Notified post and on 13.08.2024 the Commissioner furnished the wrong information which was corrected by him on 14.08.2024. Hence, he has submitted that the Applicants in earlier two cases i.e. O.A.No.427/2024 and O.A.No.462/2024 are now exempted from the transfer in this the Assembly Election though they are similarly placed in respect of the tenure like the present Applicant.
- Learned P.O. has submitted that though there is no change in the guidelines of the Clauses of Lok Sabha Elections and Assembly Elections, the explanation given in the guidelines dated 18.03.2024 cannot be made applicable to the present applicant. She has pointed out the She has pointed out the guidelines dated 18.03.2024 wherein at sub Clause (i) of Clause 6 there is mention that it is in respect of the matter of non-transferring of Mr. Iqbal Chahal, Commissioner of BMC from his present post of Commissioner of BMC Mumbai though he has put in three years. She has further pointed out that the applicant's post of Chief Officer, Kulgaon Badlapur is notified by the Election Commission Rules. Learned P.O. has submitted that the post of Chief Officer Kulgaon Badlapur is notified for Election purpose and applicant has put in total 7 years and 5 months in Thane Region and therefore though the applicant has put in only 2 months on the notified post he is liable to be transferred. Learned P.O. produces the minutes of CBS meeting dated 13.08.2024 wherein the name of applicant,

M.P. Gaikwad appears at Serial No.14 and Home Town is mentioned as Sangli and total period he has put in is mentioned as 7 years and 5 months. The reasons for his transfer is mentioned as tenure and in the last column is mentioned as 'the applicant is required to be transferred as per guidelines dated 31.07.2024 of the Election Commission'. Further it is mentioned that in place of applicant, one Mr. Pankaj Buse who is Assistant Commissioner, Kalyan-Dombivali Municipal Corporation is recommended. Learned P.O. has submitted that in view that the transfer orders are issued as per the procedure interim relief may not be granted.

- Considered submissions made by both the parties. I am of the view that at this stage, prima facie, no case is made out after going through the explanation and guidelines of Election Commission especially in respect of sub clauses (i) and (ii) of Clause 3 and sub clauses 5.1 and 5.2 of Clause 5 of the guidelines dated 21.12.2023 and Clause 4 and sub Clause (ii) of Clause 6 of guidelines dated 18.03.2024. In the transfer order the sanctity maintained by the Election Commission is required to be accepted and implemented accordingly. I am of the view that prima facie, no case is made out and no balance of convenience is in favor of the All the Respondents, especially applicant. Respondent No.3 are directed to file written submission. Applicant shall join his new place of transfer.
- 5. Learned Counsel has submitted that applicant will submit his representation that after elections he is to be bought back to Thane to complete his normal tenure on the same post.
- 6. If such representation is made it is to be decided by the Respondents thereafter within reasonable time.
