- 2. This is a High Court remand back matter which is to be decided within two months starting from 25.9.2023, as per directions of the Hon'ble High Court given on 13.9.2023 in W.P. No.10142 of 2023 filed by the applicant. The OA was decided by this Tribunal on 7.7.2023 and the same was challenged by the applicant in above W.P. and order in W.P. was submitted by the applicant in this Tribunal along with his letter dated 22.9.2023.
- 3. Applicant has filed above MA No.633 of 2023 on 3.10.2023 for adding prayer clause d(i) in the OA as per Schedule-I annexed to the MA, which reads as under:
 - "d(i) That the Respondent no.3 be directed to quash and set aside the suspension order dated 26.8.2015 issued with retrospective effect that is from 23.8.2015."
- 4. The relief trying to be sought by way of amendment is different from the reliefs as already prayed in OA. Therefore, it is necessary to reproduce the earlier relief in OA which were decided and remanded back. It reads as under:
 - (a) This Hon'ble Tribunal may kindly be pleased to quash and set aside the impugned order dated 16,2,2023 by which the respondent declined to regularize the suspension period from 23.8,2015 to 28.11,2018 till the decision of the criminal appeal.

- (d) That, the respondent no.3 may kindly be directed to regularize the period of suspension from 23.8.2015 to 28.11.2018 as per judgment passed by this Hon'ble Tribunal in OA No.524/2020 and as per decision on 1.2.2023 passed in OA No.1294/2022."
- 5. Hence, initially this Tribunal will have to decide the MA for amendment.
- 6. Ld. PO submits that by way of amendment the applicant seeks to challenge the suspension order dated 26.8.2015, which is beyond limitation and it is filed without MA for condonation of delay. Ld. PO seeks time to file reply to the MA.
- 7. Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that his senior will argue the MA and seeks adjournment till 2.11.2023.
- 8. At the request of Ld. Advocate for the applicant adjourned to 2.11.2023.
