By judgment dated 10.05.2024, Clause 5 of G.R. dated 04.05.2023 issued by Women and Child Development Department to the extent it restricted the applicability of the said G.R., only to the extent of the Advertisement No. 83/2021 issued by MPSC & to the process of recruitment commenced after 29.09.2022 was held to be unconstitutional and it was set aside. This judgment is challenged before the Aurangabad bench of Hon'ble Bombay High Court. By Interim order dated 19.08.2024, the Hon'ble Bombay High court has passed an order of 'Status Quo'.

3. It is the contention of the Applicant that the issue before the Aurangabad Bench of Bombay High Court and Bench of this Tribunal at Aurangabad was limited to the extent of Clause 5 of the said GR dated 04.05.2023 having been held unconstitutional and to that extent, Aurangabad Bench of Bombay High Court has passed the order of 'Status Quo'. Therefore, the Applicant has sought 'Interim Relief' by this M.A.

4. We have come to the conclusion that Prayer Clause (a) of the M.A can be allowed. M.A. is allowed in terms of Prayer Clause (a) and disposed of.
