"10. We have carefully gone through the submissions of both sides. Before going into merits of the case, it is necessary to look into the question of jurisdiction of this Tribunal. As regards the jurisdiction of the Tribunal, admittedly, the Applicants who were contractual employees of Slum Rehabilitation Authority (SRA) are not Government Employees. This Authority has been created by the Maharashtra Slum Areas (Improvement, Clearance and Redevelopment) Act, 1971. By Notification dated 16.12.1995, this Authority has been constituted by the Government of Maharashtra in exercise of power under sub-section (1) and (2) of Section 3-A of the aforesaid Act. The employees of SRA are not covered by Section 15(1) of the Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985 as the State Government has not issued any Notification under sub-section (2) of Section 15 of Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985 to bring the employees of SRA under sub-section (3) of Section 15 of the Act. They are not State Government employees amenable to jurisdiction of this Tribunal."

6. In the present case no such Notification is pointed out to us and no other interpretation is also advanced and hence we dismissed this matter on the point of jurisdiction.

7. In view of above, O.A. stands dismissed.



