- Heard Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri A.J. Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- Learned Advocate for Applicants states that Applicants are 'Senior Clerks' serving in establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' and seek transfer to establishment of 'Spl. I.G.P. Nashik Range, Nashik'.
- 3. Learned Advocate for Applicant further states that (a) Applicant in O.A. No.423/2024 had submitted representations to 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' for transfer to establishment of 'Spl. I.G.P. Nashik Range, Nashik' on 21.12.2020 and 09.05.2022 and (b) Applicant in O.A. No.424/2024 had made representations to 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' for transfer to establishment of 'Spl. I.G.P. Nashik Range, Nashik' on 30.08.2022 and 23.11.2022.
- 4. Learned Advocate then mentions that several 'Head Clerks / Senior Clerks / Junior Clerks' who had applied after Applicant to 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' have been transferred by (i) Transfer Order of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' dated 10.02.2023 and (ii) Transfer Order of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' Order dated 07.03.2024.

Tribunal's orders

- 5. Learned P.O. states that case of Applicant was duly considered by 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' as by letter dated 30.06.2023 Applicant was informed to submit 'Medical Certificate'. However, 'Medical Certificate' has still not been submitted by Applicant and it was the primary reason why request of Applicant could not be considered before issue of 'Transfer Order' of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' dated 07.03.2024 in respect of several other 'Head Clerks / Senior Clerks / Junior Clerks'.
- 6. Learned Advocate for Applicant thereupon contends that 'Medical Certificate' had already been submitted but yet request of Applicant was not considered at the time of issue of 'Transfer Order' of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' dated 07.03.2024 in respect of 27 'Head Clerks / Senior Clerks / Junior Clerks'.
- 7. The 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' is therefore informed to reconcile the asymmetry on information relating to submission of 'Medical Certificate' by Applicant. Thereafter; if it is found to be available on 'Office Records'; then Applicant be relieved to join on establishment of 'Spl. I.G.P. Nashik Range, Nashik' especially if any other 'Senior Clerk' who is junior in service to Applicant has already been relieved by 'Transfer Orders of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' dated 10.02.2023 and 07.03.2024.
- The reasons of seeking 'NOC' from various 'Police Establishments' viz (i) Commissioners of Police and (ii) Superintendents of Police before issuing 'Transfer Orders' of 'Head Clerks / Senior Clerks / Junior Clerks' also needs to be explained by affirming or otherwise if 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' is their 'Cadre Controlling Authority', although such employees serve in various 'Police Establishments'. If 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' is the 'Cadre Controlling Authority' then transfers of 'Head Clerks / Senior Clerks / Junior Clerks' can well be done upon observance of provisions of 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005' read with policy guidelines in G.A.D. G.R. dated 09.04.2018 without any necessity of obtaining 'NOC' from various 'Police Establishments'.

- 9. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.
- 10. Issue notice before admission returnable on 05.04.2024.
- 11. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Private service is allowed. Respondents are put to notice that the case may be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
- 12. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
- 13. By Hand delivery, speed post, courier notice to be served and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.
- 14. - 2. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that the Applicant who belongs to cadre of 'Chief Officer, Group-A' was serving on post of 'Deputy Commissioner, Pune' Municipal Corporation' since 03.03.2023.
- 3. Learned Advocate for Applicant thereupon states that Applicant came to be transferred from post of 'Deputy Commissioner, Pune' Municipal Corporation by Urban Development Department Order dated 21.03.2024 as per directions in Election Commissioner of India letter dated 18.03.2024 and further draws attention to the specific contents of its 'Para 6.2' which directs transfer of officers posted as 'Municipal Commissioners/Additional Municipal Commissioners' who had served for more than 3 years and were posted in their 'Home District'.
- 4. Learned Advocate for Applicant also states that Applicant came to be posted 'Deputy Commissioner, Pune, Municipal Corporation' on certain 'Medical Grounds'.
- 5. Learned PO based on information received from officers present mentions that 'Urban Development Department' Transfer Order dated 21.03.2024 in respect of Applicant and Others was issued for implementation of recent directions in Election Commission of India letter dated 18.03.2024.
- 6. Learned PO also relies on 'Minutes of Meeting' of 'C.S.B.' to further state that the decision to transfer Applicant was based on joint reading of earlier directions in Election Commission of India letter dated by 21.12.2023 with recent directions in Election Commission of India letter dated 18.03.2024; as Applicant would have completed tenure of 3 Years in last 4 Years on various post of 'Pune District' before 30.06.2024.
- 7. The 'C.S.B.' of Urban Development Department should have diligently noted the difference between earlier directions in 'Para 3(ii)' read with 'Para 5.2' of

Election Commission of India letter dated 21.12.2023 and those issued later in 'Para 6.2' of Election Commission of India letter dated 18.03.2023 as it was specifically in respect of transfer of 'Municipal Commissioner/ Additional Municipal Commissioners/ Deputy Municipal Commissioners'.

- 8. The 'C.S.B.' was expected to take specific note of the nuanced change in 'Eligibility Criteria' in 'Para 3(ii)' of earlier directions in Election Commission of India letter dated 21.12.2023 which was completion of tenure of 3 Years last 4 Years in 'Revenue District' instead of completion of 3 Years in present post by the 'Municipal Commissioners', Additional Commissioners /Deputy Municipal Commissioners'.
- 9. The prayer of Applicant if granted at this stage is bound to have cascading effect on large scale transfers affected recently of 'Municipal Commissioner' Additional Commissioner /Deputy Municipal Commissioners'. Therefore; it is necessary to give Urban Development Department an opportunity to submit its views about what cause of action it intends to take given the fact that Applicant has been relieved from post of 'Deputy Commissioner, Pune' Municipal Corporation.
- 10. The Election Commission of India letter dated 18.03.2024 was no doubt to be implemented forthwith in letter and spirit but in any non-prejudicial manner with reference to provisions of law in 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005' as these specific directions were in respect of those 'Municipal Commissioner/, Additional Commissioner / Deputy Municipal Commissioner' who had served more than 3 Years in their present posts. Hence; Urban Development Department is directed not to issue 'Transfer Order' of any officer to the post held earlier by Applicant which is of 'Deputy Commissioner, Pune, Municipal Corporation'.

- 4. Applicant made representation within two weeks from the date of above order. We have gone through the affidavit-in-reply dated 19.03.2024 filed by Dr. Vijay Namdeo Suryawanshi, Commissioner of State Excise. Nowhere in this affidavit-in-reply the Contemnor has stated the immediate date on which the orders of general transfer have taken place after the impugned order. We are informed by learned Counsel that the orders of general transfers were passed on 04.05.2023. On query we are informed by learned P.O. on instructions that the meeting of Civil Services Board (C.S.B.) was held on

03.05.2023. We called upon the Department to show us as to whether the case of the Applicant was considered for transfer in that general transfers pursuant to the order dated 09.02.2023. We received the answer as 'No'. In the affidavit-in-reply the Commissioner, State Excise who is Contemnor at paragraph 13 has mentioned that,

"13. I respectfully say that a hearing was given to the applicant on dt. 04.08.2023 and it was decided to consider his case at time of general transfer 2024. Taking into considerations above facts and circumstances, there is no merit in the contempt petition and hence, it is deserved to be disposed off."

- Thus the name of the Applicant is going to 5. be considered in general transfers which are going to take place in May, 2024, as this decision was taken in Special general C.S.B. meeting in June, 2023. It is clear that the order of the Tribunal was not complied with in the C.S.B. meeting which has taken place on 03.05.2023 and the name of the Applicant was not considered. Further there is no denial that the Applicant has worked in Adivasi area He was rewarded for more than five years. Rs.48000 for his good performance. We would like to point out that in paragraph 9 of this affidavit as contrary is stated to the decision given by the Tribunal 9 about the preferential posting issue.
