Learned Advocate for Applicants states that Applicants are 'Senior Clerks' serving in establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' and seek transfer to establishment of 'Spl. I.G.P. Nashik Range, Nashik'.</p> <p>3. Learned Advocate for Applicant further states that (a) Applicant in O.A. No.423/2024 had submitted representations to 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' for transfer to establishment of 'Spl. I.G.P. Nashik Range, Nashik' on 21.12.2020 and 09.05.2022 and (b) Applicant in O.A. No.424/2024 had made representations to 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' for transfer to establishment of 'Spl. I.G.P. Nashik Range, Nashik' on 30.08.2022 and 23.11.2022.</p> <p>4. Learned Advocate then mentions that several 'Head Clerks / Senior Clerks / Junior Clerks' who had applied after Applicant to 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' have been transferred by (i) Transfer Order of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' dated 10.02.2023 and (ii) Transfer Order of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' Order dated 07.03.2024.</p>

5. Learned P.O. states that case of Applicant was duly considered by 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' as by letter dated 30.06.2023 Applicant was informed to submit 'Medical Certificate'. However, 'Medical Certificate' has still not been submitted by Applicant and it was the primary reason why request of Applicant could not be considered before issue of 'Transfer Order' of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' dated 07.03.2024 in respect of several other 'Head Clerks / Senior Clerks / Junior Clerks'.

6. Learned Advocate for Applicant thereupon contends that 'Medical Certificate' had already been submitted but yet request of Applicant was not considered at the time of issue of 'Transfer Order' of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' dated 07.03.2024 in respect of 27 'Head Clerks / Senior Clerks / Junior Clerks'.

7. The 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' is therefore informed to reconcile the asymmetry on information relating to submission of 'Medical Certificate' by Applicant. Thereafter; if it is found to be available on 'Office Records'; then Applicant be relieved to join on establishment of 'Spl. I.G.P. Nashik Range, Nashik' especially if any other 'Senior Clerk' who is junior in service to Applicant has already been relieved by 'Transfer Orders' of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' dated 10.02.2023 and 07.03.2024.

8. The reasons of seeking 'NOC' from various 'Police Establishments' viz (i) Commissioners of Police and (ii) Superintendents of Police before issuing 'Transfer Orders' of 'Head Clerks / Senior Clerks / Junior Clerks' also needs to be explained by affirming or otherwise if 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' is their 'Cadre Controlling Authority', although such employees serve in various 'Police Establishments'. If 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' is the 'Cadre Controlling Authority' then transfers of 'Head Clerks / Senior Clerks / Junior Clerks' can well be done upon observance of provisions of 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005' read with policy guidelines in G.A.D. G.R. dated 09.04.2018 without any necessity of obtaining 'NOC' from various 'Police Establishments'.

9. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.
10. Issue notice before admission returnable on 05.04.2024.
11. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Private service is allowed. Respondents are put to notice that the case may be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
12. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
13. By Hand delivery, speed post, courier notice to be served and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.
14. In case notice is not collected within **seven** days or service report on affidavit is not filed **three** days before returnable date, the Original / Miscellaneous Applications shall be placed on board before the concerned Benches under the caption "**for Dismissal**" and thereafter on the subsequent date the Original / Miscellaneous Applications shall stand dismissed.

Learned P.O. refers to Sub Para 'A' of 'Para 2' of the 'Affidavit-in-Reply' filed by 'Joint Secretary, Medical Education & Drugs Department' on 27.02.2024 which mentions names of 'Professors, Associate Professors and Assistant Professors' in whose cases the earlier 'Transfer Orders' dated 30.06.2023; 13.07.2023 & 10.08.2023 of 'Medical Education & Drugs Department' have now been cancelled by 'Medical Education & Drugs Department' Government Orders dated 04.12.2023.

3. Learned P.O. thereupon states that as earlier 'Transfer Orders' dated 30.06.2023; 13.07.2023 & 10.08.2023 of 'Medical Education & Drugs Department' which were challenged have now been cancelled therefore O.A. No.1022/2023, O.A. No.1037/2023, O.A. No. 1051/2023, O.A. No.1034/2023, O.A. No.1033/2023, O.A. No.1055/2023, O.A. No.1122/2023, O.A. No. 1054/2023, O.A. No.1053/2023, O.A. No.1052/2023, O.A. No.1222/2023, O.A. No.880/2023, O.A. No.880/2023, O.A. No.871/2023, O.A. No.882/2023, O.A. No.883/2024, O.A. No.884/2023, O.A. No.888/2023, O.A. No.958/2023, O.A. No.983/2023, O.A. No.1102/2023, O.A. No.1082/2023 can also be disposed off as the grievance of Applicants are redressed on account of acceptance of their requests and subsequent issue of fresh 'Transfer Order' dated 04.12.2023 of 'Medical Education & Drugs Department'.

4. The 'Medical Education & Drugs Department' upon finishing the 'Comprehensive and Complete Review' of earlier 'Transfer Orders' dated 30.06.2023; 13.07.2023 & 10.08.2023 have cancelled most of them and hence it can be fairly expected that concerned 'Professors, Associate Professors and Assistant Professors' will not be subjected again to 'General Transfers: 2024'.

5. The 'Deans' of (i) B.J. Government Medical College, Pune (ii) Medical College, Miraj and (iii) Sir J.J. Group of Hospitals and Grant Government Medical Colleges, Mumbai to direct their 'Chief Administrative Officer' to prepare '2 - Tabular Charts' to indicate payment of 'Salary and Allowances' which are due to (a) 'Professors, Associate Professors and Assistant Professors' whose earlier 'Transfer Orders' dated 30.06.2023; 13.07.2023 & 10.08.2023 of 'Medical Education & Drugs Department' have now been either cancelled or modified by 'Medical Education & Drugs Department' Orders dated 04.12.2023; and (b) 'Professors, Associate Professors and Assistant Professors' whose earlier 'Transfer Orders' dated 30.06.2023; 13.07.2023 & 10.08.2023 of 'Medical Education & Drugs Department' have not been cancelled or modified; but they have been granted 'Interim Relief'. The '2- Tabular Charts' must include details such as (a) Name & Designation (b) Total Amount of Salary and Allowances (c) Dates of Remittances to Bank Accounts (d) Other Remarks and must be submitted by the respective 'Chief Administrative Officers' on 08.04.2024.

6. The orders of 'Interim Relief' will therefore continue in respect of those 'Professors, Associate Professors and Assistant Professors' who have filled O.A No.1017/2023, O.A No.1113/2023, O.A No.885/2023, O.A No.881/2023, O.A No.941/2023, O.A No.931/2023, O.A No.1245/2023 as their earlier 'Transfer Orders' dated 30.06.2023; 13.07.2023 & 10.08.2023 of 'Medical Education & Drugs Department' are to be contested by 'Medical Education & Drugs Department'

Learned Advocate for Applicant also states that Applicant came to be posted 'Deputy Commissioner, Pune, Municipal Corporation' on certain 'Medical Grounds'. 5. Learned PO based on information received from officers present mentions that 'Urban Development Department' Transfer Order dated 21.03.2024 in respect of Applicant and Others was issued for implementation of recent directions in Election Commission of India letter dated 18.03.2024. 6. Learned PO also relies on 'Minutes of Meeting' of 'C.S.B.' to further state that the decision to transfer Applicant was based on joint reading of earlier directions in Election Commission of India letter dated by 21.12.2023 with recent directions in Election Commission of India letter dated 18.03.2024; as Applicant would have completed tenure of 3 Years in last 4 Years on various post of 'Pune District' before 30.06.2024. 7. The 'C.S.B.' of Urban Development Department should have diligently noted the difference between earlier directions in 'Para 3(ii)' read with 'Para 5.2' of
