ORDER

1. Heard Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Ms. S.P. Manchekar, learned Chief Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

2. In O.A.No.328/2019, 46 Police Constables and in O.A.No.331/2019, 3 Police Constables who are working presently in Motor Transport Department i.e. on the establishment of Respondent No.1 are seeking repatriation to their original Department having completed more than five years' period in Motor Transport Department. In this behalf, the Director General of Police,

*Wadhwa*

Maharashtra has already taken a policy decision as reflected in Circular dated 16<sup>th</sup> July, 2018 as well as 2<sup>nd</sup> April, 2018 to the effect that the deputation period should not exceed more than five years and on completion of five years, they should be sent back to their original establishment. The Applicants have completed more than 5 years' period, and therefore, seeking direction for repatriation. In fact, the similar relief was already granted earlier in O.As.

3. The main contention of learned C.P.O. is that it is not possible to relieve the Applicants in one go, as it would affect day to day work. She submits that there are so many Police Constables, who are seniors to the Applicants working in Motor Transport Department and if the Applicants are only relieved, those Police Constables, who are seniors to the Applicants will be aggrieved and in that situation, it would not be possible to repatriate all such Police Constables at once. The difficulty for not relieving the Applicants seems to be because of not getting substitutes in their place, who are to be sent by Additional Commissioner of Police, Armed Force, Mumbai.

4. The learned C.P.O. has submitted that the Additional Commissioner of Police, Motor Transport Department has written letters dated 26<sup>th</sup> February, 2019, 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2019, 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2019 and 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2019 to Respondent No.3 – Additional Commissioner of Police, Armed Force for deputing the batch of another Police Constables, so as to repatriate the Applicants from the establishment, but there is no response from Respondent No.3.

5. Significantly, there is neither response to that letters from Respondent No.3 nor Respondent No.3 had filed reply to this O.A. It is, therefore, necessary to know the response of Respondent No.3. There seems to be practical difficulties in relieving the Applicants at once for want of substitutes. At the same time, they having completed more than five years' service, they needs to be repatriated in view of policy decision as well as decisions rendered by this

Tribunal. The Respondent No.3 was, therefore, expected to respond the requisitions made by Motor Transport Department and the steps taken by him for deputing other Police Constables in Motor Transport Department.

6. In view of above, the Respondent No.3 is directed to file Affidavit making its stand clear on the issues involved in the matter.

7. The Respondent No.3 is also directed to remain present before this Tribunal to appraise the Tribunal about the steps taken by him in the matter and to explore the solution to the problem. The learned C.P.O. is directed to inform Respondent No.3 accordingly.


