Learned Advocate for Applicant emphasizes that the case of Applicant is that of discrimination because as 'Forester' he was entitled of 'Two Tenures' in 'Territorial Branch' of 'Forest Department' as per 'Para B(1)(iii)' of 'Revenue & Forest Department G.R. dated 22.05.2017'. The Applicant as 'Forest Guard' was earlier working in 'Territorial Branch' of 'Forest Department' which has other branches such as 'Wildlife Management' and 'Social Forestry'.</p> <p>3. Learned P.O. states that 'Revenue and Forest Department' G.R. dated 22.05.2017 in 'Para B(1)(iii)' is not an entitlement but option to allow only an 'Two Tenures' in 'Territorial Branch' or 'Wildlife Management' or 'Social Forestry' which is required to be exercised by keeping in mind total length of service of concerned 'Forester' or 'Forest Guards' in each of these areas since initial appointment in 'Forest Department'.</p> <p>4. The Applicant was initially appointed to cadre of 'Forest Guard' and subsequently promoted to cadre of 'Forester'. Now, the contention of Applicant is limited to discrimination as admittedly he had completed '3 Years' of 'Normal Tenure' on post of 'Forester' in 'Satara Forest Division' and was eligible for transfer under 'Section 3(1)' of the 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005' but should have been transferred again to any post of 'Forester' in 'Territorial Branch' as per 'Para B(1)(iii)' of 'Revenue and Forest Department' G.R. dated 22.05.2017. However, in case of Applicant who now</p>

belongs to cadre of 'Forester' there is an interface between provisions of law under 'Section 3(1)' of the 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005' and 'Policy Guidelines' framed for transfer of 'Foresters' and 'Forest Guards' by 'Revenue and Forest Department' G.R. dated 22.05.2017.

5. The ground of discrimination claimed by Applicant lies in unraveling the actual pattern of implementation of 'Para B(1)(iii)' of 'Revenue and Forest Department' G.R. dated 22.05.2017'. Hence, 'Chief Conservator of Forest (Territorial) Kolhapur' is directed to refer to past records of transfers of 'Foresters' to ascertain whether in earlier instances too 'Foresters' were invariably transferred out from 'Territorial Branch' to 'Wildlife Management' or 'Social Forestry' after one 'Normal Tenure' of '3 Years' without relying on 'Para B(1)(iii)' of 'Revenue and Forest Department' G.R. dated 22.05.2017'.

6. The scrutiny of past records of transfers of 'Foresters' when done by 'Chief Conservator of Forest (Territorial) Kolhapur' will reveal to what extent 'Para B(1)(iii)' of 'Revenue and Forest Department' G.R. dated 22.05.2017' is being implemented in non-partisan manner and nature of discrimination if any exists against Applicant.

7. The 'Chief Conservator of Forest (Territorial) Kolhapur' would be expected to submit all such details in 'Tabular Chart'; so that case of Applicant can then be decided as prayers to be considered are for transfer to 'Vacant Post' of 'Forester' in establishment of 'Sangli Forest Division' or even to other 'Vacant Post' of 'Forester' in any of the 5 'Forest Divisions' under jurisdiction of 'Chief Conservator of Forest (Territorial) Kolhapur'.


