technical ground that her Advocate remained
absent, she should not be deprived for justice.



4. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A.. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
5. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

6. The service may be done by Hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.
7. Learned P.O. Smt. Archana B.K. is directed to take instructions and based thereon to make a statement on the following point :-
- As to whether the Applicant's representation for retention in Pune District till the end of academic year 2016-2017, is under consideration.
 - If it is under consideration within how much time decision would be taken.
 - Could applicant be retained at his present posting till such decision is taken.
