Learned Advocate for Applicant stated that no 'Public Compliant' had been received against Applicant relating to complicity in unfortunate incident on 13.08.2024 involving 'Young Children' enrolled in 'Private Pre-Primary School' at 'Badlapur' in 'Thane District' or about dereliction of any duties & responsibilities assigned to Applicant as 'Education Officer (Primary)' in 'Zilla Parishad, Thane' by 'School Education and Sports Department'.</p> <p>4. Learned Advocate for Applicant highlighted that on other hand it was Applicant who had promptly taken action as soon he became aware about gravity of unfortunate incident on 13.08.2024 involving 'Young Children' enrolled in 'Private Pre-Primary School' at 'Badlapur' in 'Thane District'.</p>

Learned Advocate for Applicant mentioned that Applicant had promptly obtained factual report about unfortunate incident on 13.08.2024 involving 'Young Children' enrolled in 'Private Pre-Primary School' at 'Badlapur' in 'Thane District' from the 'B.E.O.; P.S. Ambernath' in 'Thane District' on 21.08.2024 and had forthwith forwarded it for appropriate action to 'Deputy Director of Education, Mumbai Region' with endorsement made to 'Commissioner Education Maharashtra State, Pune'.</p> <p>6. Learned Advocate emphasized that 'Pre-Primary Education' which is normally provided by 'Kindergarten Schools' are not placed under jurisdiction of either (a) 'Education Officer (Primary)' or (b) 'Education Officer (Secondary) who serve in 'Zilla Parishads' & who perform charter of duties & responsibilities specified in 'Director of Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai' letter dated 25.11.1983.</p> <p>7. The Applicant who is serving on post of 'Education Officer (Primary)' in 'Zilla Parishad, Thane' has contended that he was placed under 'Suspension' only due to occurrence of unfortunate incident on 13.08.2024 involving 'Young Children' enrolled in 'Private Pre-Primary School' at 'Badlapur' in 'Thane District'. However, no mention has been made about it in 'Order' dated 23.08.2024 issued by 'School Education and Sports Department' about 'Suspension' of Applicant as per 'Rule 4(1)(a)' of 'Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1979'.</p> <p>11. The Applicant has also contended with reference to contents of G.R. of 'Women and Child Development' dated 11.10.2022 that implementation of 'Early Childhood Care & Education (ECCE)' policy was not being done by either (a) Education Officer (Primary) or (b) Education Officer (Secondary) of 'Zilla Parishad, Thane'.</p> <p>12. The case of Applicant who has been served with 'Order' dated 23.08.2024 of 'Suspension' under 'Rule 4(1)(a)' of 'Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1979' has brought to fore the vital roles of 'School Education and Sports Department & Women and Child Development Department' to separately formulate regulatory guidelines in respect of implementation of 'Early Childhood Care & Education (ECCE)' policy with reference to 'Women and Child Development' G.R. dated 11.10.2022 which is made applicable only to 'Anganawadi Centre'.</p> <p>13. The 'Women & Child Development Department' had taken initiative for implementation of 'Early Childhood Care & Education (ECCE)' policy by issuing several G.Rs dated 03.06.2016, 01.03.2019, & 11.10.2022; while 'School Education & Sports</p>

Department' after declaration of 'NEP: 2020' has constituted 'Sakhi-Savitri' committees by G.R. dated 10.03.2022 but belatedly issued specific guidelines by G.R. dated 21.08.2024 for 'Safety of School Children' after occurrence of unfortunate incident on 13.08.2024 involving 'Young Children' enrolled in 'Private Pre-Primary School' at 'Badlapur' in 'Thane District'.

14. The 'School Education and Drugs Department' should have always remained circumspect about timely formulation & stringent implementation of regulatory guidelines to prevent unfortunate incidents involving 'Young Children' as has occurred in 'Private Pre-Primary School' on 13.08.2024 at 'Badlapur' in 'Thane District'.

15. The larger issues relating to vulnerability of 'Young Children in 'Private Pre-Primary Schools' and 'Anganawadi Centres' will have to immediately addressed jointly by both 'School Education and Sports Department & 'Women and Child Department'. The responsibilities for prevention of such unfortunate incidents involving 'Young Children' cannot be placed in water tight compartments but achieved only through better institutional arrangements so that in future they do not happen at all. Hence, it is beyond rationale that only an individual can be held accountable as is the case of Applicant especially when 'School Education and Sports Department' has belatedly issued specific guidelines by G.R. dated 21.08.2024 for 'Safety of School Children' and assigned definite roles & fixed accountability on 'Education Officers (Primary)' and 'Education Officer (Secondary)'.

16. The 'School Education and Drugs Department' had issued and (i) G.R. dated 10.03.2022 (ii) G.R. dated 21.08.2024 which mentions the specific roles and responsibilities of (i) Education Officers (Primary) (ii) Education Officers (Secondary). Hence, the 'School Education and Drugs Department' will have to be given fair opportunity to present their case as to what were the determining factors which made it necessary to issue 'Order' dated 23.08.2024 for 'Suspension' of Applicant. Therefore, time of 'Two Weeks' is granted to learned CPO. Hence in the aforesaid context no 'Interim Relief' can be granted to Applicant.


