- 7. In case notice is not collected within 3 days or service report on affidavit is not filed 3 days before returnable date, Original Application shall stand dismissed without reference and papers be consigned to record.
- 8. Learned advocate for applicant prays for leave to amend the O.A. Leave to amend O.A is granted.
- 9. Issue of Interim relief is kept open. Pendency will not come in the way of the Respondents in examining the matter in view of judgments of this Tribunal in O.A nos 3709/1991 and 310/1996, 152/2004 and 117/2009.
