Learned Advocate for the Applicant came to be appointed on the post of Sub-Divisional Water Conservation Officer, Soil and Water Conservation, Sub Division, Satana, District Nashik on 17.04.2023. The Applicant joined on this post on 20.04.2023. The ordre of his predecessor Respondent No.2 Shri Ramdas S. Pawar was also issued on 20.04.2023 by which he was repatriated to his parent Administrative Department i.e. Water Resources Department as per Policy Decision taken on 31st May, 2017 at the time of creation of Soil and Water Conservation Department out of Water Resources Department.
- 3. Learned Advocate for the Applicant further stated that the Applicant came to be transferred by impugned order dated 21.09.2023 to the Vacant Post of Sub Divisional Water Conservation Officer, Z.P (MI) Sub Division, Satana, District Nashik and Shri Ramdas S. Pawar Respondent No.2 has been posted in his place as Sub-Divisional Water Conservation Officer, Soil and Water Conservation, Sub Division, Satana, District Nashik; although the impugned order dated 21.09.2023 is unusually worded as "शासनाच्या प्रदील आदेशापर्यंत तात्पुरत्या स्वरूपात मुदतवाढ देण्यात येत आहे."
- 4. Learned PO is also heard on behalf of Respondents and as to produce the File Notings. The perusal of the File Notings' clealy shows that the CSB had mentioned these facts and subsequently, when the proposal was submitted to the Competent Authority, these facts were again mentioned in the proposal submitted through 'ACS, Soil Water Conservation Department.' However, the Competent Authority directed that Shri Ramdas S. Pawar who stood repatriated to the Water Resources Department

be posted back to the post of Sub-Divisional Water Conservation Officer, Soil and Water Conservation, Sub Division, Satana, District Nashik. The use of these words "शारानाच्या पुढील आदेशापर्यंत तात्पुरत्या खरूपात मुदतवाढ देण्यात .येत आहे." suggests that these have been used to circumvent the provisions of Transfer Act 2005', and therefore, do not meet the benchmarks of transperancy in decision making expected under the Transfer Act 2005' from all Competent Authorities. The Soil and Water Conservation Department after the directions of Competent Authority re-submitted the proposal to the Minister Incharge of the Soil and Water Conservation Department to reconsider the proposal approved by Competent Authority and accept the recommendation of the CSB. However, the Minister Incharge of Soil and Water Conservation Department did not agree and insisted that the earlier orders of Competent Authorities should be implemented and thereafter the impugned order dated 21.09.2023 was issued by the Soil and Water Conservation Department. In the aforesaid context, the learned PO is informed to suggest to the Principal Secretary, Soil and Water Conservation to personally discuss the resubmitted proposal again with the Minister Incharge of the Soil and Water Conservation Department and to inform through learned PO as to whether they are willing to withdraw the impugned order of 21.09.2023. Next hearing on 4th October, 2023 under the caption of 'Urgent Admission' Hamdast granted.
