**ORDER**

1. Heard Shri K.R. Jagdale, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Smt. K.S. Gaikwad, the learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
2. The matter pertains to inter-district transfer. The Applicant is working as Talathi at Guhagar, Dist. Ratnagiri and has completed his tenure at the place and requested to post at Vita, District : Sangli being vacant and for the same category.
3. In fact, the Collector Sangli by Order dated 27.03.2017 (Page no.25 of the P.B.) favoured the proposal for transferring the Applicant to Vita, District Sangli. However, since then nothing has been materialized in spite of the said proposal addressed to the Government.
4. In view of the above contention, the learned Advocate for the Applicant seeks interim relief at least to keep the post of Talathi at Vita, District Sangli vacant, so that in case the said post is filed, the present application should not become infructuous.
5. As against him, the learned P.O. for the Respondents sought four weeks time to file reply and take instructions.

6. As discussed above, the post of Talathi at Vita, Dist. Sangli is vacant and in spite of favourable report from Collector, Sangli it has not been materialized. In such situation, interim relief is necessary to prevent irreparable loss being caused to the Applicant.

7. Therefore, I think it just and appropriate to grant interim relief in perms of prayer clause 11(b).

8. By way of interim relief it is directed to keep the post of Talathi (NT-D category) at SDO Vita vacant till the filing reply of the Respondents.

9. Issue notice returnable on 30.11.2018.

10. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

11. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

12. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
