'Additional Tahsildar, Pimpri-Chinchwad, Taluka: Haveli, District: Pune' subsequently after issuing series of Memorandums & Orders for giving & taking away 'Additional Charge' of the Applicant and various other 'Talathis submitted proposal to the 'S.D.O., Haveli Sub-Division, Pune' on 21.06.2023 regarding request of transfers of the Applicant and one other Smt. Aarti Khaire, Talathi.
- 5. The establishment of 'Talathi Cadre' has now been transferred from the level of S.D.O to District Collectors vide 'Revenue and Forest Department' G.R. dated 18.09.2023. Notwithstanding the withdrawal of authority and powers of the S.D.O. to deal with establishment of 'Talathi Cadre' the action of giving and taking away 'Additional Charge' of the Applicant and other Talathis by the 'Additional Tahsildar, Pimpri-Chinchwad, Taluka: Haveli, District: Pune' when establishment of 'Talathi Cadre' was vested with the 'S.D.O.' were brazen acts of indiscretion which were allowed to go on by 'S.D.O., Haveli Sub-Division, Pune'. overall conduct of 'Additional Tahsildar, Pimpri-Chinchwad, Taluka: Haveli, District: Pune' even amounts to in-subordination of 'S.D.O., Haveli Sub-Division, Pune'.

- 6. The 'Memorandum' and 'Orders' issued by 'Additional Tahsildar, Pimpri-Chinchwad, Taluka: Haveli, District: Pune' by usurping the authority and powers of 'S.D.O.' are therefore liable to be quashed and set aside. Besides it will not be out of context to observe that such 'State of Affairs' cannot be permitted to continue and appropriate remedial action needs to be taken by the 'District Collector of Pune' to obliterate indiscretion in performance of duties, responsibilities by officers working in the Cadre of Tahsildar.
- 7. The Memorandum and Orders issued between 06.03.2023 to 21.06.2021 qua the Applicant is therefore quashed and set aside. The Applicant is accordingly allowed to continue to work on the post of 'Talathi, Saza Charoli Budruk, Taluka: Haveli' to which she was initially posted by 'Transfer Order' of 'S.D.O., Haveli Sub-Division, Pune' dated 24.05.2022. However, the 'District Collector of Pune' will' be at liberty to take further appropriate decision about the Applicant as per G.R. of 'Revenue & Forest Department' dated 18.09.2023 but in observance of the provisions of 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005.'

1. Learned counsel submitted that the applicant retired on 30.4.20220 and he has filed the present O.A No. 110/2023 for directions to release the retiral dues

with interest as his retirement dues were not paid. In the said matter on 19.4.2023, the Tribunal passed the following order:-

- "5. In view of the above, O.A is disposed of with direction to the Respondents to release retiral benefits of the Applicant as per his entitlement if there is no legal hurdle to release the same within a month from today.
- 6. In case there is any such legal hurdle or any legal issue, Respondents should communicate the same to the Applicant within two weeks from today.
- 7. Respondent Nos 1 to 3 are jointly and severally are responsible for the compliance of the above direction.
- 8. The Applicant is at liberty to redress the grievance of interest on delayed payment independently."
- 2. Learned Counsel has already filed rejoinder.
- 3. Learned P.O. has stated that today during the course of the day she will file sur-rejoinder. It be taken on record. Copy be served upon the concern. Learned P.O. has submitted that the Respondent has not paid regular pension, leave encashment and gratuity to the Applicant. However, other pensionary benefits have been paid to the Applicant such as:-
 - (i) Final GPG payment of Rs. 2,63,441/- is pad on 11.01.2021.

- (ii) GIS Rs.1,20,358/- on 21.12.2020
- (iii) Provisional Pension from 01.05.2020 to 31.10.2020 of Rs.2,03,232/- on 06.08.2021.
- (iv) Provisional Pension from 01.11.2020 to 31.10.2021 of Rs.,4,09,648/- on 24.12.2021.
- (v) Provisional Pension from 01.11.2021 to 30.06.2023 of Rs.7,94,968/- pm 31.07.2023
- (vi) 7th Pay Commission arrears 2nd and 3rd installments of Rs.1,00,508/- and 4th installment of Rs. 50,254/- on 03.08.2023
- 4. Learned P.O submits that the order of the Tribunal could not be complied with because of the legal hurdle of pendency of departmental enquiry.
- 5. Learned counsel submits that the Applicant retired on 30.04.2020 and the chargesheet was served on the applicant after retirement i.e., on 29.10.2021 for the incidences which occurred in the year 2017 and 2018 which were within four years preceding his retirement. As per para 6 of the order dated 19.04.2023 of the Tribunal, learned Counsel has submitted that though it was to be communicated to the Applicant within two weeks after receiving the notice, the Respondents communicated about the pending D.E. to the Applicant on 23.06.2023. Learned Counsel relies on order dated 09.06.2021 passed in O.A.No.608/2020, Shri C.M. Kadam Versus State of Maharashtra. The Applicant in



O.A.No.608/2020 is the co-delinquent, wherein this Tribunal had directed the Respondent to release gratuity, regular pension, leave encashment after adjusting interest on home loan due against Applicant within a month from today. The benefit of the said order cannot be granted to the Applicant in the present case, as the said order was passed on 09.06.2021 when the D.E. was not initiated against the present Applicant and other delinquent on 29.10.2021. Applicant is entitled for gratuity, leave encashment within three months of the retirement.

- 6. In view of Rules 120(2), 121, 122 & 123 of the Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1982, we are of the view that not giving the regular pension, gratuity and leave encashment to the Applicant within a stipulated period, though order is passed by this Tribunal on 19.4.2023, especially when the departmental enquiry was not initiated when he retired, prima facie, we hold that it is a good case to issue notice under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1977.
- 7. Issue notice to the Respondents as to why action should not be taken against them under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1977.
- 8. Smt Sangita Ghumatkar, Director, Directorate of Forensic Science Laboratory, Mumbai, is directed to



remain present before this Tribunal on 1.11.2023 at 10.30 am.

- 1. Heard Mr. Bhushan A. Bandiwadekar, learned Counsel for the Applicant and Ms. S.P. Manchekar, learned Chief Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- The Disciplinary Authority, Collector, Sangli by order dated 23.03.2016 has passed order in D.E. that Rs.200/- is to be deducted permanently from the salary of the Applicant. Thereafter, the Applicant filed appeal before the Divisional Commissioner. The Divisional Commissioner by order dated 31.03.2017 confirmed the said punishment, but with some modification in respect of regularization of suspension period. Thereafter, challenging the said order he preferred revision on 07.11.2019 under Rule 25 of the Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline and Appeal) Rules, 1979 (hereinafter referred as 'MCS Rule 1979' for brevity), making Collector i.e. Disciplinary Authority and Divisional Commissioner as the Appellate Authority and on 07.11.2019 it was communicated to the Applicant that he has wrongly filed the appeal before the Government and in view of Rules 18 and 25 of the MCS Rule 1979, an appeal is to be filed before the Divisional Commissioner as he is the competent authority. The mistake is committed by

the Applicant who has wrongly translated the word 'revised' as 'पूर्णविलोपन' which should have been written as 'पूर्णविरक्षण'. When in the caption and in the array of the Respondents the Collector and Divisional Commissioner are made party and it is mentioned that the application is moved under Rule 25 of the MCS Rule 1979 that the word is 'revised', it appears that it has happened inadvertently.

- 3. Hence, the impugned order is set aside. Applicant may file application with the Collector regarding the words 'पूर्णविलोपन' and 'पूर्णविरक्षण'. Thus, the Government to entertain the words 'revised application' and to decide the same afresh on merit within two months after filing of fresh O.A.
- 4. In view of above, O.A. stands disposed of.
