2. The applicant is a Class-IV employee working on the post of Laboratory Attendant. Applicant was initially appointed as Laboratory Attendant at Kolhapur. After having served at Kolhapur for more than 05 years, the applicant applied for interdivisional transfer and his request has been accepted and he came to be transferred in Aurangabad Region vide order dated 11.10.2003. Thereafter the applicant was given posting vide order dated 17.10.2023 as Laboratory Attendant in Government Arts & Science College, Aurangabad and within few days thereafter i.e. on 20.10.2023 another order has been passed, thereby cancelling his inter-divisional transfer and directing him to join at his previous post at Kolhapur. The impugned

order shows that earlier orders have been cancelled on the ground that such provision is not applicable for the employees working in Class-IV category and is applicable only for the employees working in Class-III category. Learned counsel for the applicant pointed out that in the past several Class-IV employees have been given such benefit and such orders are placed on record. Learned counsel submitted that the applicant is likely to be relieved in pursuance of the impugned order and if it so happen, irreparable loss will be caused to the applicant, since he has completely shifted his family from Kolhaput to Aurangabad and has also taken admission in the School at Aurangabad for his children.

3. Learned Presenting Officer has sought time for taking instructions from the respondents and to file the affidavit in reply. Learned P.O. submitted that the concerned G.R. pertains to Class-III employees only and the order in regard to inter-divisional transfer of the applicant from Kolhapur Region to Aurangabad Region has been cancelled with retrospective effect and in the circumstances no

interim relief is to be granted as has been prayed for by the learned counsel for the applicant.

4. After having considered the submissions advanced by the learned counsel for the applicant and the learned Presenting Officer and after perusal of the documents filed on record, inter-divisional transfers of even Class-IV employees seem to be in practice. The order by which the applicant came to be transferred from Kolhapur Region to Aurangabad Region also includes other 02 names of Class-IV employees. - 2. We have read the office objection. The applicant has filed the Misc. Application for condonation of delay stating therein that the delay occurred is of 3 years and few months. According to the office note, the period of delay is more than the period as stated.
- 3. Even after having availed due opportunities, the affidavit in reply has not been filed by the respondents.
- 4. According to the contentions raised in the M.A. and the submissions made by the learned counsel appearing for the applicant, the delay caused is of 3 years, 10 months and 17 days. The contention so

raised is apparently unacceptable. The cause of action had arisen much earlier. Only because the respondents did not respond to the representations made or did not consider the request or did not consider the previous service, will not save the period of limitation. The delay caused is to be considered from the date of entitlement as sought by the applicant i.e. from the year 2003. However, considering the fact that the relief, which has been sought may have an impact on the amount of pension, we are inclined to condone the delay, which has occasioned in filing the accompanying O.A., however considering the period of delay, by imposing certain costs on the applicant. Hence, the following order:-
