


This is O.A. filed by 33 Applicants jointly seeking protection to their present pay. Initially they were in Zilla Parishad (Z.P.) service. However, later they were selected on nomination in State Government service in 2013. At the time of appointment in Government service their pay was protected as seen from order dated 06.04.2015 on the basis of G.R. dated 23.03.1994 as specifically mentioned in the order.</p> <p>3. However after six years Respondent suddenly issued communication dated 29.09.2021 issuing direction to withdraw the pay protection and to re-fix their pay in Government service, with recovery.</p> <p>4. The perusal of impugned communication dated 07.09.2021 reveals that it is primarily based upon some observation made by this Tribunal in O.A. No.327/2013 decided on 17.09.2014. Whereas perusal of the Judgment reveals that it was pertaining to continuity in service and subject of pay protection seems not directly in issue. All that Tribunal observed that:-</p> <p align="center">"If the State Government in the past had extended benefit of continuity in service to some other employee who were working in Z.P., we are sure steps will be taken to correct such mistakes."</p> <p>5. Thus it is on the basis of this Judgment impugned communication has been issued without giving an opportunity of hearing to the Applicant. Indeed Judgment in O.A. No.327/2013 reveals that the Applicant therein was seeking Deemed date of service from 10.10.1979 in the cadre of Jr. Engineer which was date of his joining of service in Z.P. Tribunal also</p>



observed that continuity in service can be for purposes of pension but it cannot be counted for seniority. Thus the *prima-facie* issue involved in O.A. No.327/2013 seems to be centered upon counting the service for seniority.

6. In view of above, I am satisfied *prima-facie* case is made out for stay to impugned order.

7. Interim relief in terms of para.11 of O.A. is granted till filing of Reply.

8. Issue notice before admission returnable on 24.12.2021.

9. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

10. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of Original Application.
