2. Aggrieved by the order dated 10-06-2023 this O.A. is filed whereby the applicant has been transferred to District Hospital, Beed from his existing posting at Panchayat Samiti, Vaijapur, Dist. Aurangabad. It is the grievance of the applicant that grave mistakes have occurred in effecting transfers of officers like the applicant because of some glitch in the inputs provided in the software prepared for the purpose. Learned Counsel pointed out that the transfer policy is quite clear and it provides the transfer, first as per seniority of the candidate concerned in the District, if it is not possible in the District then in the Division. Learned Counsel pointed out that since the transfers seem to have been effected on the basis of the persons holding qualification at a particular place, for example, the MBBS against the MBBS and

PSM against PSM, which was not the policy of the Government. Learned Counsel submitted that the applicant has not yet been relieved from his existing post.

3. Learned Counsel further submitted that large scale complaints are received against the transfer orders issued for the current year. Learned Counsel further submitted that having regard to the number of such complaints, the State has decided to consider the grievances of such officers. Learned Counsel submitted that the present applicant has also submitted his grievance online, however, the same has not yet been considered and resolved by concerned authorities. Learned Counsel submitted that the applicant is quite sure that the grievance if considered by the authorities, the applicant will certainly be entitled for his posting according to his seniority and the preferences given by him at Kannad in Dist. Aurangabad or may be at Soygaon, Dist. Aurangabad. Learned Counsel submitted that until the said representation is decided it would be unjust to ask the applicant to relieve his charge of existing post.

- 4. Learned Counsel further submitted that the applicant will accept the decision given by the authorities on his representation. In the circumstances, the interim relief is sought by the applicant to till then allow him to work at his existing post.
- 5. Learned P.O. submitted that as per the instructions latest received to the office of CPO, respondent no.5 is reported to have submitted his joining report with DHO. Learned P.O. has expressed his inability to make any concrete submission for want of necessary instructions from the respondents. He has sought time to submit the affidavit in reply.
- 6. After having considered the submissions made on behalf of the applicant and more particularly having regard to the fact that the applicant has made a representation as required by the respondent authorities and the same is yet to be decided, there appears prima facie case in favour of the applicant. It is significant to note that the applicant has undertaken to abide by the decision which may be taken by the respondent authorities on his representation.

7. In the circumstances, I see no difficulty in accepting the request of the applicant for grant of interim relief in his favour. In the circumstances, following order is passed:

ORDER

- 8. Respondents are directed not to relieve the applicant and allow him to work at his existing post till the next date or till the date his representation is decided, whichever is earlier.
- 9. Time is granted to the respondents for filing affidavit in reply till 14-07-2023.

It is the case of the applicant that he will be retiring on attaining the age of superannuation on 30.6.2024 and in such circumstances he should not have been transferred from his existing post that too at the place 350 Kms away from his existing posting. The learned counsel for the applicant has relied upon the provisions under section 5(1)(a) of the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (for short the Transfer Act, 2005), as well as, the Government Resolution dated 9.4.2018. The learned counsel. in the circumstances, has prayed for ad. interim relief as has been prayed in the Original Application and thereby

to stay the impugned order till the decision of the present O.A.

- 3. Shri S.K. Shirse, learned Presenting Officer submitted that right now he does now have instructions in the matter and has therefore sought 2 weeks' time to file the affidavit in reply. learned P.O. submitted that 4 candidates transferred vide the same order by which the present applicant has also been transferred, had approached the Principal Bench of this Tribunal, but the Tribunal has declined the interim relief in their favour. The said order is tendered for my perusal by the learned P.O.
- 4. The learned counsel for the applicant on instructions submitted that the applicant has not yet been relieved and no one has been posted in his place. The learned P.O. expressed his inability to make any statement as about the facts so stated on behalf of the applicant.
- 5. I have duly considered the submissions advanced on behalf of the applicant and the respondents i.e. the State authorities. I have also

gone through the order of Principal Bench in O.A. Nos. 555 and 592 both of 2023. It is quite evident that the facts of the cases before the Principal Bench at Mumbai are different than the facts involved in the present matter. Having regard to the facts which are existing in the present matter, a primafacie case is certainly made out by the applicant. The applicant is retiring on 30.6.2024. In the circumstances, as per the provisions under section 5(1)(a) of the Transfer Act, 2005 and G.R. dated 9.4.2018 the applicant has certainly made out a case for his retention at the existing place. Hence, the following order:-

Issue notice to respondents, returnable on 10.7.2023, till then the respondents shall allow the applicant to work on his existing post.

2. Being aggrieved by the order dated 10.6.2023 the applicant has approached this Tribunal. aforesaid order the applicant has transferred from Primary Health Centre, Somthana, Badnapur, Dist. Jalna to Primary Health Centre, Daulatabad, Dist. Aurangabad. The learned counsel for the applicant submitted that the applicant was due for transfer and accordingly his options were called for. 10 options were asked for accordingly the applicant has submitted the said options well within the time. It is the grievance of the applicant that though at the places for which the applicant has given options are vacant, applicant has not been considered for his transfer to any of the said posts and has been transferred at P.H.C., Daulatabad, Dist. Aurangabad for which the

applicant has not given any option. It is the further case of the applicant that being a specially abled person the applicant has some privileges like to ask for the posting at the nearest places from his residence/hometown. The learned counsel submitted that even otherwise the cases of the specially abled persons are considered sensitively and on some privileged parameters.

3. The learned counsel submitted that transferred is at the distance of 70 Kms. place Badnapur/hometown of the applicant. The learned counsel pointed out that initially one list was published by the respondents wherein the applicant was shown to have been transferred at the Principal, Health and Family Welfare Training Centre, Aurangabad. The learned counsel submitted that the said list is stated to have been withdrawn and a new list has been published. The learned counsel submitted that except 2 changes i.e. one Dr. Rekha Chate has been brought at the post at Aurangabad, where the applicant was transferred and now the applicant has been transferred to the place, where

said Dr. Rekha Chate earlier transferred. In the circumstances, the applicant has alleged the impugned order to be illegal and in violation of the provisions under the Transfer Act, 2005 and the rules and G.Rs. issued thereunder. The learned counsel submitted that the applicant has not yet been relieved from his existing post.

- 4. The learned Presenting Officer has sought time to file the affidavit in reply. The learned P.O. has sought 2 weeks' time to submit the affidavit in reply. The learned P.O. further submitted that according to the instructions received to him today the applicant has been relieved from his existing post. The learned counsel for the applicant has disputed the fact so stated. The learned counsel on instructions further submitted that no one has yet been posted in place of the applicant at P.H.C. Somthana, Badnapur, Dist. Jalna.
- 5. I have duly considered the submissions made on behalf of the applicant and the State. Primafacie there appears no dispute about the fact that the applicant has not been given transfer at any of

10 places for which he has submitted his choices. The document filed on record by the applicant reveals that earlier he was given posting by way of transfer on one of his preferred place and subsequently the said order has been revised. Prima-facie, though there appears substance in the contentions as are made on behalf of the applicant, unless the affidavit in reply is received from the respondents, the reason behind making transfer of P.H.C.. the applicant at Daulatabad. Dist. Aurangabad is difficult to be identified. However, having regard to the fact that till today no one has been posted in place of the applicant even though it is accepted that the applicant has been relieved as submitted by the applicant, an interim arrangement can be suggested to keep the applicant at his existing place and post till the affidavit in reply is filed by the respondents. The merits in the contentions raised in the application can scrutinized only after the affidavit in reply is received from the respondents. Hence, the following order:-

ORDER

Issue notice to respondents, returnable on 10.7.2023, till then the respondents shall allow the applicant to work on his existing post.

- 2. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
