This matter was mentioned before me by Mrs Kranti Gaikwad, learned P.O along with Shri Mohanty, legal advisor to the Commissioner of Police, Mumbai. Learned P.O stated that by order dated 6.1.2016 this Tribunal has imposed cost of Rs. 1000/- each on Respondents no 2 & 3 on the ground that affidavit in reply was not filed in time.
