It is his further contention that, in spite of that

vide order dated 19.1.2022 (page 34 of paper book) the applicant has been relieved from the present post and is directed to join on the promotional post at Nagpur. The learned Counsel for the applicant has submitted that the applicant has not yet vacated his present office and no one has been appointed till date on the said post where the applicant is presently working. The learned Counsel further submitted that the applicant has right to deny the promotion and accordingly he has exercised the said right. In the circumstances, the relieving order could not have been issued by the authorities. In the circumstances, the interim relief is sought by the applicant for staying the effect and operation of the letter dated 19.1.2022 issued by the respondent no. 2.

3. The learned Presenting Officer has sought time for seeking instructions from the respondents and has further come out with a contention that in the correspondence made by the applicant, he has not clarified that he has denied the promotion.

4. We have gone through the documents and the contents of the Original Application. The fact of denial
