1. Heard Smt. Punam Mahajan, the learned Advocate for the Applicants and Ms. N.G. Gohad, the learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
2. Learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents states as follows :-
 - (a) Instructions are received from Respondent No.3 praying for four week's time for filing-in-reply on the ground that para-wise remarks are called from lower office, which are awaited.


