The Applicants have made representations to Joint Director, Technical Education, Mumbai Region (Respondent No.3) for condonation of delay/break in service and to grant the benefit of Time Bound Promotion considering their initial date of appointment. In response to it, the Responoent No.3 had called certain information from the Principal, Government Polytechnic Collage, Satara as seen from the letter dated 04.02.2003. However, no further steps were taken in respect of their representations.</p>

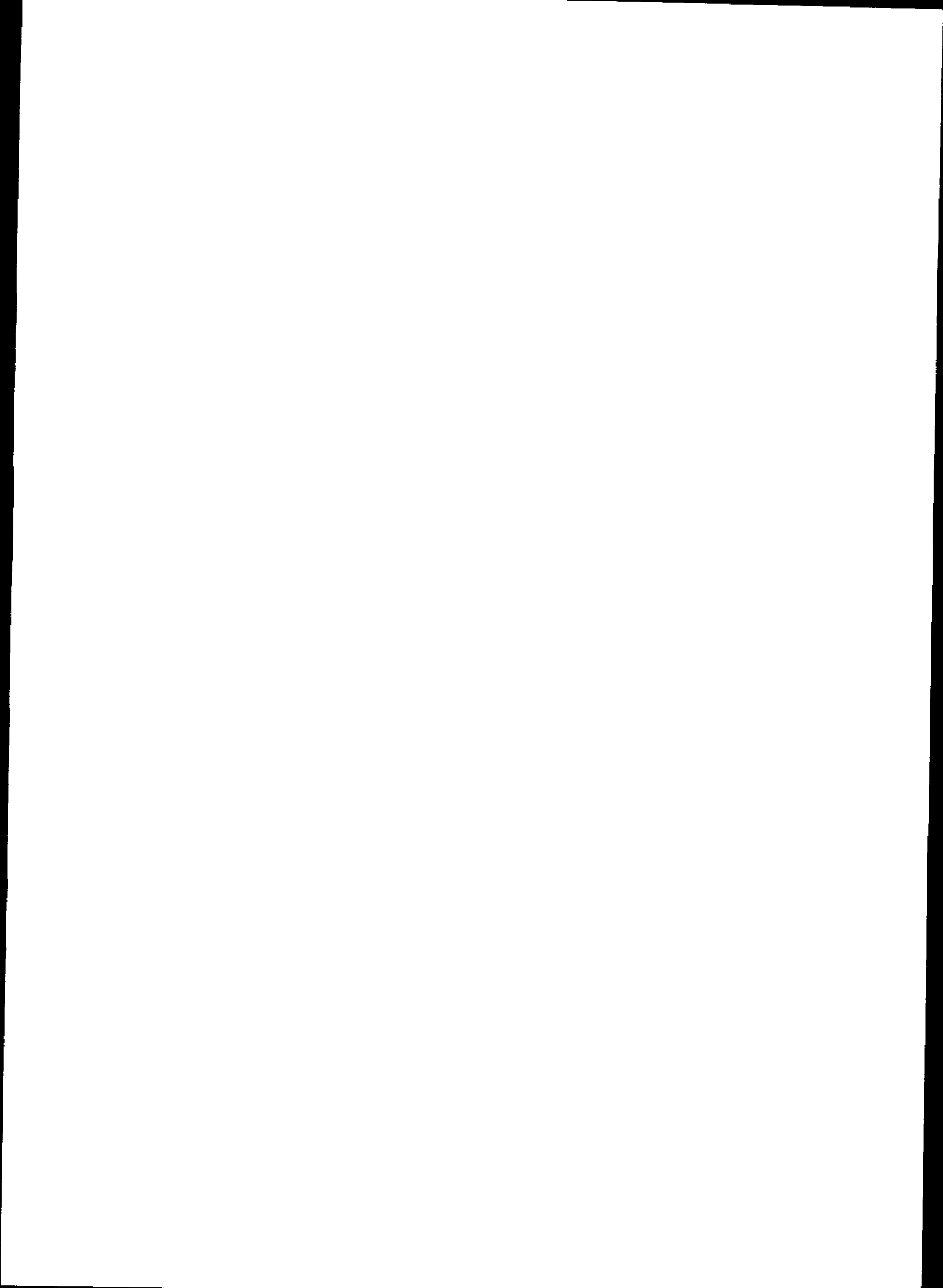

She has tendered a copy of order which is taken on record.

4. Perusal of order reveals that the period of suspension is already treated as duty period under Rule 73(3)(4) of Maharashtra Civil Services (Joining Time, Foreign Service, and Payments during Suspension, Dismissal and Removal), Rules 1981 subject to the decision of appeal preferred by the State Government against discharge of the Applicant from Criminal Case and the decision of Departmental Enquiry.

5. As such, in view of above, grievance of the Applicant is already redressed and O.A. has become infructuous.

6. Original Application is accordingly disposed of with no order as to costs.

It is really astonishing that the Applicant stands retired on 30.09.2013 and still not getting his retirement benefits and the Respondents despite various representations made by the Applicant from time to time did not take any decision which constrained the Applicant to approach this Tribunal.</p> <p>3. Today, the matter is fixed for final hearing and during the course of hearing, it is transpired that the representations made by the Applicant from time to time are just sent from one table to another table and no final decision is taken.</p> <p>4. The Applicant was appointed on the post of Sub Editor in Urdu Academy in 1980. The said Academy is under the domain of General Administration Department. The Applicant was continued in service and service book was maintained, yearly increments were paid. Besides, the benefits of 4th, 5th and 6th Pay Commission were also granted.</p> <p>5. During service itself, the Applicant has made various representations right from 1999 which is at page Nos.85, 86, 87, 89, 90, 91, 81, 82, 84 and 92. Thus, from 1999 to 2010 he made various representations adverted above. Even after retirement, the Applicant made representations for grant or retiral dues which are at page Nos.116, 117, 118 and 120 of the Paper-Book.</p>

	<p>6. It appears that some note of the representation of the Applicant was taken by the department but no final decision was taken. It seems that objections were also raised that the Applicant was appointed without any recruitment rules but the department forgot to note that he was given all the benefits on par with regular employees. The record further reveals that the file was tossed from Minority Development Department to General Administration Department and vis-à-vis but no final decision is taken. All the while, the departments indulged in raising the quarries about the recruitment rules. At one of the time, the then Additional Chief Secretary Dr. T.F. Thekekara had also submitted the proposal before the Cabinet for regularization of the services of the Applicant which is at page Nos.110 to 114 (The note is without date).</p> <p>7. Thus, it seems that the departments were trying to pass buck to each other and eventually the Applicant got retired but no decision is taken though the period of six years is over from his retirement. Suffice to say, inaction and Insensitiveness of the concerned officials is writ at large.</p> <p>8. In view of above, it is necessary to direct the Respondent No.1 to take final decision on the various representations made by the Applicant as well as the proposals forwarded by the department inter say within a month from today so that the matter can be decided on merit.</p> <p>9. In view of above, the Respondent No.1 is directed to coordinate with concerned other departments and to take decision on the representations made by the Applicant.</p> <p>10. The Respondent No.1 is, therefore, directed to depute its responsible officer not below the rank of Joint Secretary to be present in the Tribunal on the next date along with the concerned file and the decision on the various representations made by the Applicant.</p> <p>11. 

She referred to G.R. dated 14.10.2011 which is absolutely irrelevant in the present situation. It was expected from the learned P.O. to take appropriate instructions to find out as to whether there are any legal grounds to cancel the posting but no such effort is made. Learned P.O. further submitted that she had no further instructions from the department and whatever department instructed her that she is placing before the Tribunal.

5. In view of above, I am inclined to grant interim relief restraining the Respondents from filling up the vacancy on which the Applicant was promoted and posted by order dated 21.12.2018, so as to protect his right.

6. Interim relief is granted as per prayer clause 10(b) of the O.A.

7. One week's time is granted to learned P.O. to take appropriate instructions and to file reply, if necessary so that matter can be heard and decided finally at the stage of admission.
