1. Heard Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Smt K.S. Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

2. Learned P.O. states that so far they have not received any information regarding observations & directions in 'Para 6' to 'Para 9' of Order dated 14.12.2023. Therefore 'Affidavit-in-Reply' could not be filed on behalf of 'Transport Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Mumbai.'

3. The 'Transport Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Mumbai' had been deputed as 'Election Observer' during 'General Elections Lok Sabha: 2024' thus may not have found adequate time to diligently look into the contents of O.A. No.1538/2023 and provide 'Parawise Comments'. However, as 'General Elections Lok Sabha 2024' are now over and 'Transport Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Mumbai' has since resumed regular 'Administrative Work'; the pending 'Parawise Comments' should be submitted within 'One Week'. The 'Affidavit-in-Reply' to be filed thereupon must provide requisite information with reference to detailed observations & directions in 'Para 6' to 'Para 9' of Order dated 14.12.2023 regarding 'Computerized Transfer System' operationalized during 'General Transfer: 2023' for 'Assistant Inspector of Motor Vehicle'. Also if 'Computerized Transfer System' is planned to be used during 'General Transfer : 2024' for transfers of 'Assistant Inspector of Motor Vehicle'.

4. The 'Joint Commissioner' / 'Deputy Commissioner' in office of 'Transport Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Mumbai' who had directly supervised implementation of 'Computerized Transfer System' during 'General Transfer: 2023' for 'Assistant Inspector of Motor Vehicle' to personally remain present along with all supplementary information as may be sought with reference to detailed observations & directions in 'Para 6' to 'Para 9' of Order dated 14.12.2023.

5. The case of Applicant in particular relates to 'Solapur District'. In 'Affidavit-in-Reply' dated 27.03.2024 it is mentioned that Applicant was placed at 'Sr. No. 219' and had 'Priority' No.6' as per 'G.A.D. G.R. dated 09.04.2018'. Thus; considering that there were 11 'Vacant Posts' of 'Assistant Inspector of Motor Vehicles' in 'Solapur District' which were filled up during 'General Transfer : 2023' it is only to be ascertained if those who got transferred to 'Solapur District' through 'Computerized Transfer System' during 'General Transfer: 2023' were all placed above 'Sr. No.219' held by Applicant and were also placed higher than or at par with Applicant ranging from 'Priority No.1' & 'Priority No.6' as per 'G.A.D G.R. dated 09.04.2018.' Such classified information for 'Solapur District' is to be produced with respect to case of Applicant.

6. Learned P.O. may by way advisory convey to 'Transport Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Mumbai' about procedure that has been adopted for 'Computerized Transfer System' by 'Skill Development & Entrepreneurship Department' as incorporated in their G.R. dated 20.09.2019.

Learned Counsel has submitted that the Applicant was denied promotion for one more reason i.e. the Applicant holds Diploma in Public Health from Kerala University and the State of Maharashtra does not recognize the same. The Applicant therefore filed O.A.No.849/2018 which was decided by order dated 04.02.2022 by M.A.T. Bench Aurangabad wherein the Tribunal considered the post graduate diploma in Public Health (D.P.H.) from the Sree Chitra University as adequate qualification for conferment of promotion as District Health Officer in terms of Maharashtra Medical and Health Services, Class-I, Recruitment Rules, 1981.

4. Learned Counsel has further submitted that when the D.P.C. meeting was conducted on 28.12.2020, the Department did not consider the year-wise vacancy from 1st September and Respondents clubbed all the vacancies from 2012 to 2018. He has further submitted that in the D.P.C. meeting held in 2018 and 2020 all the 17 reserved posts were kept aside and only 20 posts were filled up by the Department. At the time of D.P.C. meeting dated 11.04.2018 and 13.04.2018, the Applicant was placed at Sr. No.1383 for 37 posts.

5. Learned C.P.O. has informed the Tribunal in short that the applicant did not fall in the consideration zone and never reached to that seniority, to be given promotion to the post of D.H.O. Learned C.P.O. has relied on the Additional Affidavit dated 23.11.2023 filed on behalf of Respondent through Ms. Karuna B. Surwade, Chief Administrative Officer, in the office of Commissionerate of Health Services, Mumbai. She pointed out Annexure R-5 of the said affidavit, the chart furnished by the Respondent giving details of dates of the D.P.C. meeting and promotions given.

6. It is mentioned in the said Chart that in the D.P.C. meeting held in the year 2019-20 the first eligible candidate was at Sr. No.108 of the seniority list for the period from 1996 to 2008 and the last candidate was at Sr. No.549 in the seniority list published in the year 2009. Applicant's seniority in the year 2009 is at Serial No.627 which puts him out of the zone of consideration. In the year 2021 the Rules were changed by Notification dated 18.01.2021 wherein amendment was made for promotion to the post of D.H.O. IN the said G.R. 25% quota weightage was given to M.B.B.S and Diploma persons. In the D.P.C. meeting held on 18.04.2022 the first candidate was at Sr. No.151 and last candidate was at Sr. No.894, the Applicant was at Sr. No.3430. It is seen that again the Applicant was out of the zone of consideration. In the D.P.C. meeting held on 25.08.2023 the first candidate was at Sr. No.1079 and last candidate was at Sr. No.1273, the Applicant was at Sr. No.2638. It is seen that again the Applicant was out of the zone of consideration.

7. At the request of learned Counsel adjourned to 02.07.2024.

3. Learned Counsel Ms. Sirpurkar has submitted that transfer is sought as the Applicant Dr. M.P. Motghare (O.A.No.33/2024) has retired on 31.01.2024 and Applicant Dr. Pramod B. Khandate (O.A.No.483 /2024) is due to retire on 30.06.2024. She has submitted that the issue of extension of age of retirement of Medical Officers upto 60 years is already taken up for hearing by M.A.T. Mumbai. She has submitted that in view that the issue involved in the present O.A. being similar and also as no Division Bench is available at M.A.T. Bench Nagpur, M.A.No.371/2024 seeking transfer of O.A.Nos.33 & 483/2024 be allowed.

4. Learned C.P.O. Ms. Manchekar has opposed the M.A. stating that the pleadings are all complete and the matter is placed for hearing before M.A.T. Bench Nagpur.

5. Learned Counsel has further submitted that the Applicant Dr. Pramod B. Khandate (O.A.No.483 /2024) is due to retire on superannuation on 30.06.2024. She has submitted that in view that interim relief was granted to the applicant in O.A.No.1107/2023, similar relief be granted to the Applicant in present case.

6. Learned C.P.O. Ms. Manchekar submits to the orders of the court.

7. M.A.No.371/2024 is allowed. In view that in similar matter i.e. O.A.No.1107/2023 at M.A.T. Mumbai the arguments of learned Counsel and learned C.P.O. are heard, however in the said matter learned Counsel has sought time to file rejoinder and the said O.A. is adjourned to 03.07.2024. It is a fact that at present there is no Division Bench at M.A.T. Bench Nagpur and the pleadings in O.A.No.33/2024 & O.A.No.483/2024 are complete. Thus both the O.As are allowed to be transferred from M.A.T. Bench Nagpur to M.A.T., Mumbai. This would avoid multiplicity of the proceedings and save time of the Tribunal. Matter fixed on 03.07.2024 between 12.30 p.m. to 2 p.m. Mr. S.A. Deo, learned C.P.O. for the Respondents at M.A.T. Bench Nagpur may appear as he has filed affidavit-in-reply.

8. Thus, interim relief is granted to the Applicant Dr. Pramod B. Khandate (O.A.No.483/2024) till final decision in the O.A.No.1107/2023.
